Board of Directors Meeting Minutes  
Prairie Grove Shooting Sports  
11/2/19

- Meeting called to order by Kevin Hess - VP. Ralph Gates – DAL, Michael Rodney – PG, Craig Maravich – STL, Rob Gyngard – GW, Bill Spurlock – ST. Six board members constitute a quorum.
- Last board meeting on 8/30/19 were approved.
- Treasurer’s report was approved.
- Hall of Fame and Charlie Smith Award for 2020 was tabled until the next meeting.
- The 2020 State Championship will be at St. Louis Skeet & Trap on 8/28/20 – 8/30/20.
- The 2021 State Championship will be at Gateway Gun Club. Date not set.
- The board recommends continuing with the rotation method for awarding the State Championship.
- United Sportsman Club in Jefferson City application is approved. Club dues are waived for 2020.
- 2020 member dues will remain the same. \$15 if paid to Treasurer directly, and \$20 if paid at a shoot.
- 2020 club dues are reduced to \$50.
- NSSA has set up a website [www.nssausopen.com](http://www.nssausopen.com), to answer questions about the 2020 US Open, which is an iShoot.
- The Zone 5 Championship will be at the Minneapolis Gun Club. They have ten 30 amp RV spots.
- The NSSA has some new programs in the works. Such as 25% of Federal ammo and free gun floater insurance with paid NSSA membership. Details haven’t been released yet.
- Rookie of the Year has been tabled until after the 2019 NSSA score data is available in February 2020.
- Jeff McClure with MidwayUSA Foundation, Inc. made presentation whereby youth shooters could have some funding to help support for the their shooting. The board authorized Bill Spurlock to investigate the details, and to open an Agency Account, with an initial deposit of \$500 from the MSSA.
- This was Michael Rodney’s final board meeting as he is retiring from the MSSA board after 25 years. His service was greatly appreciated. John Brummett will replace Michael as the club director from Prairie Grove.
- Meeting was adjointed.
