- Treasurer's report: approved
 - 1. Received \$382 grant from the Midway USA Foundation for youth shooting at the 2025 state shoot.
- New business
 - 1. United Sportsmens Club, Gateway Gun Club, Springfield Rod & Gun Club and St. Louis Skeet & Trap have renewed their NSSA Club Membership.
 - 2. Prairie Grove hasn't filed a MSSA shoot report for the Great Pumpkin, held in October 2024. \$75 in target fees are due. Their 2025 NSSA club dues are unpaid.
 - 3. 2025 State Shoot at Busch Shooting Range The NSSA won't issue a shoot certificate until the 2025 club dues are paid. Target cost will be \$20 per 100.
 - 4. 2025 State Shoot Grant Application submitted, but NSSA might not accept it, as the host club's dues are unpaid.
 - 5. Correction: For the 2025 season, and additional 1¢ per target fee is to be paid to fund the state shoot medals. Total target fees for 2025 season will be 3¢ per target.
 - 6. 2026 is will be Missouri's turn to host the Zone Shoot. Need a club, which is capable and willing to host it. A minimum of five fields would be required. 2024 Zone shoot had 66 attending. Busch might be able to hold it, but only on four fields, which would require a four rotation shoot. The two unresolved issues are the required Friday cocktail party, and parking.
