RESPONSIVE READING**CHRIST'S CONCERN FOR CHILDREN****Matthew 18:1-6, 10; Mark 9:37; 10:13-16**

LEADER:	At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?
CONG:	And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them.
LEADER:	And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted; and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
CONG:	Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is in the kingdom of heaven.
LEADER:	And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.
CONG:	But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.
LEADER:	Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.
