## **BREEDING CONTRACT**

1. This mare is booked by name and this contract is valid to this mare only. Neither contract nor the return privilege can be transferred or sold without written permission from the stallion owner.

2. A photo clearly showing the conformation of the mare and a copy of her registration papers must accompany this document. Stallion Owner reserves the right to refuse any mare service for any reason, with or without explanation. If stallion owner exercises this right this contract and any payment sent will be returned within 30 days of receipt.

3. The Mare's health condition is the responsibility of the Mare Owner. The Mare Owner will ensure that the mare is in sound breeding condition. We recommend that mare owner's vet will examine and assess your mare's breeding soundness, and your mare should have a negative uterine culture and/or biopsy prior to breeding (but is not required). We expect you to follow your veterinarian's recommendation.

4. We recommend that the mare owner vaccinate the mare for Rhinopneumonitis (Equine Herpes Type 1) at 5,7, and 9 months of pregnancy. The mare owner shall also ensure that the mare is kept in proper condition, and be kept up to date on all worming and all other vaccinations.

5. Mare must be checked for pregnancy and ultrasounded by a veterinarian 14-17 days post breeding. The mare should be re-checked between 28-35 days for a heartbeat. The Mare owner must inform stallion owner of the above named mare's pregnancy status by day 60.

6. Should 3 timely inseminations that do not achieve a pregnancy occur, mare owner agrees to A): substitute the mare and/or B): substitute the vet/clinic used. Before a 4th shipment will be sent, mare owner agrees to provide proof of a current "negative" culture & cytology and proof of a favorable uterine biopsy. Stallion Owner requires a clean culture and cytology for mares that have failed to become pregnant in the prior year, but strongly suggest using the practice in any breeding situation.

7. The full stud fee of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ must be received before any semen will be shipped. Please make the payments to Linda deBoer via etransfer, money order, PayPal, personal cashier's or certified check.

8. The stallion stud fee **does not include collection/processing fees.** Disposable container or equitainer deposit and shipping fees are the responsibility of the mare owner. Shipping arrangements via FedEX can be organized by PLOUGH EQUINE for you if needed.

It is the responsibility of the mare owner to confirm and provide a credit card to **PLOUGH EQUINE VET SERVICES** or **MOORE EQUINE** for collection charges **AHEAD** of collections.

Semen is to be collected Monday-Friday if possible, 24 notice is required for orders. Please call ahead for availability, collection dates are dependent on the stallion's training/show schedule.

9. Stallion Owner agrees to provide fresh cooled semen in viable condition from the selected stallion at the time of delivery, to the Purchaser at the approved address. Stallion owner is not responsible for any semen shipments that are lost, delayed or damaged during transport. This semen must be administered by a licensed veterinarian or by a breeding technician approved by stallion owner on the day of delivery, or the LFG and the contractual obligations are nullified.

10. The semen shipment from the selected stallion is to be used only on the mare named in this contract. If the semen is used on a mare other than the above named in the contract, the full-posted stud fee of the stallion and contract is due immediately.

11.. The Purchaser must contact stallion owner for semen shipments **24 HOURS PRIOR** to the day of the requested semen shipment. For semen shipments placed after the 24 hour time period, we will try to fulfill them, but we cannot guarantee them, and they may be subject to a rush order fee. Semen orders will be filled in the order in which they are received, our standard semen shipment includes, but does not guarantee, 2 doses.

12. Purchaser understands that the stallion or stallion owner may be away from the farm during the breeding season and will not always be available for collection. It is the Purchaser's responsibility to contact the farm for dates the stallion will be available for collection. Stallion Owner will make every attempt to provide the schedules to the Purchasers well in advance.

13. The Purchaser assumes all responsibility for the condition of the mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the mare whatever by death, disease, injury, infection or otherwise, and by any cause whatever, including inappropriate, untimely, or negligent insemination or failure of insemination and therefore releases, discharges, indemnifies and hold harmless stallion owner, employees and agents from any and all damages associated therewith.

14. The Purchaser agrees if using the mare for embryo transfer, in the event of producing more than one embryo, an additional stud fee is due to Blue Moon Stables for each additional pregnancy.

15. If the mare fails to conceive during the breeding season the Purchaser is entitled to a return breeding the following year. Please inform stallion owner by no later than October of the above named year as to whether or not your mare is in foal or not. A vet certificate is required. This report must be sent to stallion owner, so that the Live Foal Guarantee and return breeding will be honored. It will be the Purchaser's responsibility to pay the new seasons collection, transportation and deposit fees.

16. Live Foal Guarantee: If the mare, after being checked in foal, aborts or does not produce a live foal that can stand and nurse on its own, up to 48hrs after birth, the Purchaser is entitled to a return breeding in the following year. It will be the Purchaser's responsibility to pay the booking fee, collection, transportation and deposit fees. A veterinary certificate is required within five (5) days from the date of death and/or examine. Otherwise the LFG is Null and void.

17. It is agreed that should the stallion be sold, die or be unable to produce viable semen, Stallion owner will substitute frozen semen (max 2 doses if available) from the selected stallion. Maximum time limit on this contract is two (2) years.

18. Mare owner agrees that this contract shall be governed by the laws of the Province of British Columbia, Canada.
