BIOG (<300 words)

Katrina is most widely known for writing and performing the newsreader spoof Sandra Sultry, for the Ch10 TV sketch series THE WEDGE as part of the lead ensemble cast, alongside Rebel Wilson, Kate Jenkinson, Jason Gann, Julie Eckersley and Adam Zwar. Katrina also was one of the lead ensemble writer/performers on the sketch/mockumentary series FLIPSIDE which she co-created with brothers, Stephen Curry, Andrew and Bernard Curry for ABC TV. Her first key acting role was playing the lead role of streetkid, Mezza in the telemovie ECONOMY CLASS for Ch 7 with Dennis Moore, Marg Downey and Bud Tingwell, directed by Kevin Carlin and produced by Stephen Luby; she was a Moosehead Award Melbourne International Comedy Festival two-hander dramedy FOOTY CHICKS with Fiona Harris directed by Roz Hammond, a regular voice-cast ensemble member for the long-running, weekly narrative comedy radio serial THE BREAKFAST SHIFT for ABC 774 with Stig Wemyss, Grant Piro and Paul McCarthy, and has appeared in many independent theatre and films. In the short MAGGIE-MAY, by Mia'kate Russell, she was nominated for Best Supporting Actor at the Terror in the Bay Film Festival; and in the multi-award-winning web series INCOMING: WORDS OF WAR, she was one of seven key cast nominated for Best Ensemble at the NZ WebFest and Asia Web Awards, and won in that category at the British Web Awards. In the last few years, Katrina has been seen as the fumbling presenter in a Reflex Paper TVC; the depressed mum in a Tones & I music video NEVER SEEN THE RAIN (35+ million views). She's performed regularly in independent annual theatre events, such as the annual MADWOMEN MONOLOGUES at The Butterfly Club and the PLAY SIX festival at Cracked Actors and been involved in various rehearsed screenplay and play readings, including the lead role of Jackie in the screenplay TANKED by Kerry Drumm; the mum, Olivia Pescado in Bill Marshall's WILD NIGHTS OF YOUTH; Patti the bank-robber in Cerise de Gelder's HOSTAGE; B.J. Hyman in Samantha Hill's THE LAST DAYS OF BETTE DAVIS and various roles in Marty MonStar's MADRINA as well as the lead role (written for her) of Joan Archer Private Detective in Marty MonStar's THE RANSOM LETTER. Katrina regularly works as an independent voice over artist, with a particular interest in narrative animation. Years ago, she played the nurse in the original SAW short film by Leigh Whannell and James Wan and she's performed played lead guest roles on TV shows including WILFRED, ALL SAINTS, CITY HOMICIDE, PRANK PATROL and BLUE HEELERS.

Katrina was a regular ensemble actor for the THE WEDGE (Ch10); FLIPSIDE (ABC TV) and weekly radio serial THE BREAKFAST SHIFT (ABC 774).
