This Middlesex County guide includes parks, festivals, farmers markets, and where to take the kids on a Saturday.

CIRCLE THESE EVERY YEAR

Spring

Woodbridge St. Patrick's Day Parade – A lively hometown parade with marching bands, community organizations, local groups, and plenty of green throughout downtown Woodbridge.

Rutgers Day (New Brunswick & Piscataway) – A huge, free campus-wide celebration with science demonstrations, performances, children's activities, food, athletics, and hands on exhibits for all ages.

Celebrate Middlesex County (Edison) – A free family festival at Roosevelt Park featuring interactive displays, county services, live entertainment, children's activities, demonstrations, and food.

New Jersey Fold Festival (North Brunswick) – A long-running celebration of music, dance, food, crafts, and cultural traditions, held as part of the county's FolkLIVE event series.

Earth Day at the EARTH Center (South Brunswick) – An environmentally focused family event with gardening demonstrations, nature activities, educational exhibits, and programs about conservation.

East Jersey Old Town Village Spring Events (Piscataway) – Step inside a collection of restored historic buildings for demonstrations, crafts, exhibits, and family programming inspired by early New Jersey life.

Metuchen Memorial Day Parade (Metuchen) – A traditional Community parade honoring local veterans, followed by ceremonies and neighborhood gatherings in the borough.

Summer

Middlesex County Fair (East Brunswick) – One of the county's biggest family traditions, with carnival rides, games, agricultural exhibits, animals, live entertainment, fair food, and nightly attractions.

Milltown Fourth of July Parade – Milltown's signature tradition fills the borough with marching bands, floats, local organizations, decorated homes, and generations of hometown pride.

Stars & Stripes Drone and Fireworks Festival (Perth Amboy) – A waterfront Independence Day celebration with live music, food trucks, artisan vendors, family activities, a drone light show, and fireworks over the bay.

South Amboy Independence Day Celebration – A family-friendly celebration featuring music, food, community activities, and fireworks with views across Raritan Bay.

Woodbridge Independence Day Celebration – A large community celebration with live music, food vendors, children's activities, and a major fireworks display.

Carteret Independence Day Festival - A waterfront celebration with live performers, food vendors, family entertainment, and fireworks near Veterans Pier.

Concerts By The Bay (Perth Amboy) - Bring a lawn chair to Bayview Park for free Sunday performances by the Garden State Symphonic Band overlooking the waterfront.

Perth Amboy Arts and Flow Concert Series - A summer series featuring salsa, soul, funk, pop, and other live music styles at parks and public spaces throughout the city.

Music In The Park (Various County Parks) - Free outdoor performances rotate among county locations, including Thompson Park, Spring Lake Park, and Raritan Bay Waterfront Park.

Thompson Park Summer Concerts (Monroe Township) - Relax beside the lake with free evening performances covering oldies, rock, tribute music, and family-friendly entertainment.

Roosevelt Park Summer Concerts (Edison) - Outdoor concerts at one of the county's most popular parks, with plenty of room for blankets, lawn chairs, and a casual family evening.

South Amboy Food Truck Festival - A downtown and waterfront gathering with food trucks, live music, vendors, children's activities, and local businesses joining the celebration.

Carteret Latin Fest - A high-energy cultural festival celebrating Latin music, dance, food, and Carteret's diverse community.

Perth Amboy Dominican Festival - A celebration of Dominican culture featuring live music, dancing, traditional food, vendors, and community pride.

Perth Amboy Puerto Rican Festival - A colorful cultural celebration with music, food, dance, entertainment, and activities honoring Puerto Rican heritage.

Metuchen Street Fair - Main and New streets fill with food, craft vendors, local businesses, entertainment, and family activities in the center of downtown.

Metuchen Kids Takeover - A downtown event designed around children, with games, activities, entertainment, and family-friendly programming throughout the business district.

Plays-in-the-Park (Edison) - Outdoor musical theater at Roosevelt Park, where families can enjoy full-scale summer productions beneath the stars.

Port to the Past (Perth Amboy) - A free summer program at the Historic Ferry Slip Museum combining local history, guided tours, music, children's crafts, and family activities.

Fall

South Plainfield Labor Day Parade and Celebration - One of the borough's biggest traditions, combining a community parade with music, food, family activities, festivities, and evening fireworks.

Middlesex County Jazz Festival (Multiple Towns) - Several days of free jazz performances hosted across communities such as Woodbridge, Carteret, Metuchen, and New Brunswick.

FolkLIVE Cultural Festivals (North Brunswick and other County Locations) - County festivals highlighting folk music, cultural dance, heritage displays, crafts, storytelling, food, and family activities.

Cranbury Day - The historic village comes alive with local vendors, food, music, children's activities, community groups, and events around Main Street.

Old Bridge Day - A large hometown festival with food vendors, live entertainment, community organizations, games, activities, and attractions for children.

East Brunswick Day - A community celebration bringing together local businesses, civic organizations, entertainment, food, and activities for residents of all ages.

North Brunswick Heritage Day - A major township celebration with live entertainment, food vendors, cultural performances, children's attractions, and fireworks.

Monroe Township Oktoberfest - A seasonal community festival with food, music, vendors, children's activities, and traditional fall entertainment.

East Jersey Old Town Village Harvest Events (Piscataway) - Historic demonstrations, traditional crafts, seasonal activities, and family programming recreate the atmosphere of an early New Jersey harvest.

Metuchen Country Fair - downtown fall tradition with local organizations, food, vendors, activities, entertainment, and a strong community-block-party atmosphere.

Highland Park Arts in the Park - An outdoor celebration of local and regional artists with handmade goods, live performances, food, and activities along the borough's walkable downtown streets.

Dunellen HarvestFest - A downtown fall festival featuring local businesses, food, music, vendors, seasonal activities, and entertainment for children.

Middlesex Borough Community Day or Street Fair - A hometown gathering with neighborhood businesses, food vendors, civic groups, music, children's activities, and community demonstrations.

Woodbridge Oktoberfest - A fall celebration with seasonal food, live music, vendors, family activities, and traditional Oktoberfest-inspired entertainment.

Von Thun Farms Fall Festival Weekends (South Brunswick) - A full fall outing with pumpkin picking, corn mazes, hayrides, farm animals, children's attractions, and seasonal food.

Giamarese Farm Fall Harvest (East Brunswick) - Pick apples and pumpkins, explore the farm, and enjoy a classic seasonal experience close to home.

Winter and The Holiday Season

Woodbridge Winterfest and Holiday Stroll - Downtown Woodbridge celebrates the season with lights, music, local shopping, family entertainment, festive activities, and appearances by Santa.

Downtown Metuchen Holiday Events - The borough's walkable downtown hosts caroling, seasonal shopping events, family programming, decorations, and holiday activities throughout December.

Carteret Holiday Festival - A large community celebration with holiday entertainment, children's activities, seasonal displays, food, and a tree-lighting ceremony.

Perth Amboy Holiday Events - Smith Street and the waterfront host seasonal celebrations, music, community performances, children's activities, and holiday displays.

New Brunswick City Center Holiday Events - Downtown festivities include seasonal performances, dining events, family activities, decorations, and entertainment near Monument Square.

State Theatre Holiday Shows (New Brunswick) - A reliable destination for holiday concerts, family productions, classic films, dance performances, and seasonal stage shows.

East Brunswick Winter Wonderland - A family holiday celebration with lights, crafts, music, entertainment, seasonal activities, and visits with Santa.

Old Bridge Winterfest - A township holiday gathering with festive displays, children's entertainment, seasonal refreshments, activities, and a community tree lighting.

South Amboy Tree Lighting and Holiday Celebration - A hometown celebration featuring music, children's activities, Santa, refreshments, and the lighting of the city tree.

Milltown Holiday Train and Tree Lighting - A small-town holiday tradition that brings families together for seasonal displays, entertainment, Santa, and the borough tree lighting.

Jamesburg Holiday Tree Lighting - A cozy downtown celebration with music, community groups, seasonal treats, Santa, and the lighting of the borough tree.

Cranbury Christmas Lights and Holiday Events - Historic Main Street becomes especially picturesque during the holidays, with decorations, community activities, local shopping, and seasonal gatherings.

Plainsboro Founders Day and Holiday Events - Community celebrations throughout the year bring together local organizations, music, food, activities, and family entertainment.

PARKS & OUTDOORS

Roosevelt Park (Edison) - A county favorite featuring walking paths, an eight-acre lake, fishing, picnic areas, playgrounds, and the Stephen J. Caestro Theatre, home to the popular *Plays-in-the-Park* summer performances.

Thompson Park (Monroe Township / Jamesburg) - One of Middlesex County's largest parks with a lake, miles of walking trails, playgrounds, sports fields, picnic groves, fishing, and one of New Jersey's premier disc golf courses.

Johnson Park (Piscataway) - A beautiful riverside park offering walking paths, playgrounds, fishing along the Raritan River, picnic groves, athletic fields, and easy access to East Jersey Old Town Village.

Cheesequake State Park (Old Bridge) - One of New Jersey's most unique state parks where forests, wetlands, and salt marshes meet. Enjoy hiking, camping, kayaking, fishing, swimming, and scenic trails for every skill level.

Raritan Bay Waterfront Park (South Amboy) - A scenic waterfront destination perfect for walking, biking, fishing, watching boats on the bay, and catching spectacular sunsets over the Raritan Bay.

Carteret Waterfront Park (Carteret) - A revitalized waterfront featuring walking paths, playgrounds, mini golf, Veterans Pier, seasonal concerts, and beautiful views of the Arthur Kill.

Donaldson Park (Highland Park) - Known for its beautiful cherry blossoms each spring, riverside walking paths, playgrounds, athletic fields, and one of the area's most popular dog parks.

Merrill Park (Colonia) - A local favorite with paved walking loops, multiple playgrounds, fishing ponds, picnic areas, athletic fields, and plenty of space for family gatherings.

Middlesex Greenway (Metuchen • Edison • Woodbridge) - A paved rail-trail stretching several miles through the county, perfect for biking, jogging, walking, rollerblading, and stroller-friendly family outings.

Jamesburg Park Conservation Area (Helmetta • Jamesburg • East Brunswick) - Over 1,500 acres of protected forests, wetlands, and trails offering hiking, wildlife photography, bird watching, and a peaceful escape into nature.

John A. Phillips Open Space Preserve (Old Bridge) - A hidden gem featuring wooded hiking trails, wetlands, wildlife viewing, and some of the county's most scenic natural landscapes.

Rutgers Gardens (New Brunswick) - A free botanical garden with themed gardens, walking paths, bamboo forests, seasonal blooms, and family-friendly educational programs.

East Jersey Old Town Village (Piscataway) - More than a park, this restored 18th and 19th-century village lets families explore historic homes, barns, exhibits, and seasonal living history events.

Ireland Brook Conservation Area (South Brunswick) - A quiet preserve with wooded hiking trails, streams, wildlife, and one of the county's best spots for bird watching and peaceful nature walks.

Spring Lake Park (South Plainfield) - Popular for its paved walking trail around the lake, fishing, playgrounds, sports fields, and year-round community events.

Crystal Springs Family Waterpark (East Brunswick) - The County's premier outdoor waterpark with slides, splash areas, a lazy river, and attractions for all ages—perfect for hot summer afternoons.

DeVoe Lake (Spotswood) - A peaceful neighborhood lake offering fishing, walking paths, and a quiet place to relax in the heart of Spotswood.

Helmetta Pond (Helmetta) - A scenic pond surrounded by trees and wildlife that captures the borough's quiet, woodland character.

Cornelius Low House Museum (Piscataway) - A historic Georgian home featuring changing exhibits focused on Middlesex County history, culture, and local heritage.

The Arts Institute of Middlesex County - Home to rotating exhibits, performances, workshops, and community arts programming that celebrate local artists and creativity.

FARMERS MARKETS

Metuchen Farmers Market - A local favorite in downtown Metuchen.

Highland Park Farmers Market - One of Middlesex County's longest-running farmers markets.

Rutgers Community Farmers Market at Jones Ave (New Brunswick) - A community-focused market offering fresh produce and educational programming in partnership with Rutgers University.

Cook's Market (North Brunswick) - Located at Rutgers Gardens, this seasonal market connects visitors with local farmers, specialty food vendors, fresh produce, and beautiful garden surroundings.

Monroe Farmers Market (Monroe Township) - Held seasonally at the Monroe Township Library, this market features local farms, fresh produce, baked goods, honey, flowers, and handmade goods from regional vendors.

John and Joan Roadstand (Piscataway) - A family-run roadside farm stand known for fresh seasonal fruits and vegetables, flowering plants, vegetable starters, and classic Jersey sweet corn.

Dieker's Farms (South Amboy) - A longtime family farm offering seasonal fruits, vegetables, pumpkins, flowers, and other farm-fresh products throughout the growing season.

Indyks Farm (Monroe Township) - A popular roadside farm market offering seasonal Jersey produce, flowers, plants, and locally grown fruits and vegetables directly from the farm.

WEEKEND TRIPS WITHIN AN HOUR
