



### Responsibilities

- Liaise with the Senior Management team to identify areas of opportunity and design profitable business strategies.
- Generate and present insights such as trends, projections and statistics to key financial and business stakeholders.
- Elicit, analyse and validate business processes, systems, and requirements through facilitation of workshops, interviews and consultations with the appropriate stakeholders.
- Design, develop, and implement innovative and appealing user-friendly reports and dashboards. Actively assist all eight business units with performance and business analytics reports as well as workflow tools produced in visualisation tools like Tableau, MicroStrategy and Excel.
- Document business requirements and functional design through user stories.
- Build efficient, sustainable and well documented code. Create MS SQL, Python and VBA automations to data mine external reports and automate in house processes.

## Highlights

- During November 2019 to March 2020, I run business wide workshops to educate the leadership team and
  relevant employees on the proper use of data visualisation tools. This project enhanced the organisation's
  capabilities to efficiently utilise existing and future reporting, which accordingly leads to better decision
  making in line with our strategic goals. Fortuitously, the timing was perfect and our business managed to
  minimise the interruptions caused by covid over the following months.
- Lead the planning and developed the "Business Interruption COVID 19" dashboard at record speed. For the size of the report and the fact that it was an unplanned project I estimate that it would normally take 6-8 weeks but I managed to complete it in just 18 days! This allowed the leadership team to prioritise responsibilities properly, leading us to an all-time high customer service result in the midst of the pandemic.
- Ongoing statistical analysis on the 5 programs introduced by WorkSafe for the financial year 2020 2021.
   My analysis compares the effects of these programs on the selected claims as opposed to the control groups. Even though the data aren't yet well developed to show the long term effects, there are already actionable insights generated on which we are building winning business strategies.

- Optimized a sequence of actions to excel on the injured worker survey, a factor upon WorkSafe remunerates us. On this survey, injured workers are asked about our communications quality, actions timeliness and general satisfaction. I was tasked with identifying the most troublesome processes leading to inefficiencies and consequently lower survey scores. The most interesting of my findings was that a few processes had disparities between the timeframe that we were working on versus the one the survey was evaluating, leading to us doing the job after the survey was already conducted. The business implemented my advice to swift the time window of the process and soon enough our results in the category were improved significantly.
- Being recognised for my numerous contributions to our social committee, responsible for organizing social events and team building experiences.

Over the span of my studies I completed 39 courses in total; 8 in Statistics, 7 in Algebra & Geometry, 15 in Mathematical Analysis, 7 in other disciplines of mathematics and 2 in Developmental Psychology and Socialization Theories.
