Accessible Toilet Update from the Secretary

Over the past month, although it may appear not much has happened, a lot has being going on behind the scenes.

Robert Hebden kindly gave his time to put in the soap dispenser and toilet roll holder and hang the blind, which meant that the toilet is now finished, pending sign off from the Buildings Inspector. Buildings Regulations forms were completed and the Inspector came last week. We are awaiting his report. He did confirm that the toilet can now be used.

In the meantime, the builders have sent their invoice that requires some discussion. This will not be paid until the Buildings Inspection Report has been received and the accessible toilet has been signed off, as there may be changes to make. I have asked for compensation for all the problems we have encountered.

New Internal Door

We know this is stiff to open. When I received the first complaint, I reported it and the fitter came back. Unfortunately, nothing can be done as it's the new spring that is making it heavy. This will ease with time. We are looking into the possibility of having a push button opening on the door.

Under no circumstances, should this door ever be propped open as it is a main fire exit and this is against Fire Regulations. If this is propped open, please inform the bar staff or committee immediately.



Renewals have commenced. The deadline is 30th April.

If you joined the club between 15th December 2024 and March 2025, you do not need to do anything as your joining fee takes you to April 2026. Please ignore all emails asking for renewals.

Every member that joined before 15th December 2024 must complete a renewal form and pay at the bar. The cost for renewals this year is £25.

Life Members are required to complete the renewal form and pay £5.

Membership cards must be brought with you in order to process the renewal. If you have lost your card, please complete the renewal form and bring cash to pay, as we cannot take a card payment without your membership card.

From 1st April 2025, the cost of replacing lost cards will be £7.00.

The bar staff are happy to take renewals, but not at busy times, such as Saturday evenings please.
