



From 1st April 2025, the cost of replacing lost cards will be £7.00.

A week in the life of the Club Secretary

After the President did his "Week in the life of..." in the last newsletter, I have been asked to go next.

My job has grown a lot since I joined in 2021. There's the usual weekly and monthly tasks such as general admin, payroll, HR, testing fire alarms and safety lighting reading the meters (if you see me on my knees on the pavement with a screwdriver, I'll be reading the water meter).

I organise monthly committee meetings, special meetings and the yearly AGM and OGM, producing the agendas and taking Minutes and ensuring the CIU rules are adhered to. To think that I was told in the 80's that nobody would need shorthand by the 90's - how wrong they were!

I produce the monthly newsletter, collecting items for it throughout the month and this is emailed out to members and posted on our webpage.

Renewals take up a huge amount of time in March to May. Members' cards are swiped by the bar staff (or me) and this updates the tills. It will also update the door system (for the first time this year, I hope it works!) I then list each cash and credit card payment for the Treasurer and update the members' database. The bar staff are a great help with renewals.

New members are processed weekly. There are also changes to existing members' details and a few lost or damaged cards to deal with. With over 880 members, there's always something that needs tweaking or fixing.

I oversee contracts (utilities, wifi, Initial, Sky etc) and research the best deals before they expire.

Room hires bring in much needed revenue, from room fees as well as commission earned from the two great caterers we work with. I always carry the diary with me in case I get a call for a booking. As well as the one-off bookings, we have regulars, such as Activelies, the Yoga class and Unite. Speaking of Unite, every other month, on a Sunday morning I, with Midge's help, cook their breakfasts. I also supply the hot food for the Mencap darts team.

Staying on the subject of food, I book the food vans for Saturday nights. I try to get a different type of food every week, but do not always succeed. I have found some new catering vans this month and hope everyone will like them.

The house next door is owned by the club and rented by a lovely couple. Midge and I carry out yearly inspections. I ensure that we are compliant with the rules and regulations that seem to come out yearly, along with electrical installation certificates, landlord's gas certificates etc. I have one eye on the Renters' Reform Bill to ensure we don't miss doing something important.

I also ensure the club is compliant annually with licensing, certificates, and submissions to the Financial Conduct Authority and the CIU.

With such an old building, there's lots of maintenance required and negotiating with tradesmen. Some have gone well (£50,000 compensation in the bank and the driveway resurfaced/fence replaced for free) and some not so well (accessible toilet that should have been completed last year). I liaise with the company daily and it has been a very frustrating few months. We are just waiting for Anglia Fire & Security to put back the fire alarm fixtures and the Buildings Regs to be signed off and we can open it. Hopefuly, this will be by the end of the week.

I order any items needed for the club (except the goods for the bar as Pete does that). I recently bought a ramp to enable people in wheelchairs or on scooters to get from the lounge or bar into the Accessible toilet. We want to make the club accessible to all. .

Three years ago, I organised our first MacMillan Coffee morning. We have now held three. Some committee members and club members help and it's grown every year. We have raised well over £2,000. I start collecting raffle prizes months in advance and everyone is so generous with their time and money for this cause.

Apart from covering for the Treasurer in her absence, this explains most of what keeps me occupied. There are a great bunch of regulars that come in daily and they, along with the other staff members, make it a great place to work.

We have a new charging station in the Bar. You pay by tapping your card.

£3 per hour—Max £6 per day

£12 Temporary Deposit

Once you return the power bank, the full deposit is refunded minus the rental cost.

Longer than 1 Day?

Your rental fee stops at £6 per day. After 4 days, you have paid the purchase price of £24 and the power bank is yours to keep.

This charging machine costs the club nothing, but we earn 10% on all charges and also from advertising fees from the screen.
