

SLIDING DOOR ALARM AND JIMMY BAR DIRECTIONS

IF YOU OR A MEMBER OF YOUR GROUP (OR A VISITOR) HAVE ANY DIFFICULTY IN FIGURING OUT HOW TO LOCK AND SECURE THE DOOR, YOU MAY CONTACT ME AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY OR NIGHT AND I WILL ARRANGE FOR THE HANDYMAN TO RESPOND TO THE HOUSE TO EXPLAIN HOW TO LOCK THE DOOR OR ACTIVATE THE ALARM.

WHEN NO ADULT IS PRESENT TO SUPERVISE MINOR CHILDREN IN THE POOL AREA, THE DOOR MUST BE LOCKED AND ALARMED. THIS APPLIES 24/7/365.

IF YOU AS THE PRIMARY RENTER HAVE ANY CONFUSION ABOUT THIS DOCUMENT PLEASE CONTACT ME IMMEDIATELY AND I WILL EXPLAIN IT TO YOU VERBALLY AND GO OVER THE STEPS REQUIRED TO PROPERLY SECURE THE DOOR.

This below picture shows the jimmy bar and door alarm.

How to use:

-close slider. Using your left hand push the slider door against the frame and at the same time activate the lock on the sliding door, that is above the handle, by turning.

-release the jimmy bar and extend the bar by depressing the thumb switch. Then place in "holder" as shown in the picture.

-motion alarm. Using the remote control "fob" that is "tagged" with the word "alarm", depress the large button to turn on the unit. To turn off the alarm, depress the "unlock" button below the large button. The "fob" is kept on a hook to the left of the alarm device.

In the event of a "true emergency" such as a fire, where the guest needs immediate egress, there is an escape hammer and fire extinguisher located next to the sliding door. Follow the instructions on the "box" to release the hammer. The hammer is then used to break the glass sliding door. The hammer may also be used to break the glass windows.
