MESSAGE FROM THE DEAN



I was robbed at gunpoint. The year was 1973, and it was in a downtown Miami restaurant on Biscayne Boulevard when I was a college sophomore. A friend from work was with me and there were a number of other people in the restaurant with us, all out for a late evening dinner. My back was to the entrance door of the small restaurant. Suddenly, I noticed that my colleague's eyes widened considerably, and he was totally focused on whatever was happening behind me. I turned around just in time to stare down the barrel of a black revolver. It's not something that one forgets. Ever.

The robbers shouted to everyone: "Pull out your wallets and purses, empty them of cash, and put all your jewelry on the table." Everyone complied--thankfully--or there might have been gunfire, and someone might have died that evening. I was a college student of meager means, so all I lost was a little cash, a ten-dollar watch (it was 1973, after all), and my sense of confidence that downtown Miami was a safe place to be after dark. My co-worker was heartsick about losing a watch which he had bought in Switzerland.

In spite of some losses, I also gained something that day. I gained a profound attitude of gratefulness to God that we all were alive, unharmed, and could go about our lives after the police came and took our names and statements. Being thankful is possibly one of the most important things we can do in our daily lives. Even when the days are dark, and evil seems to be all around us, the Light of the World dispels the darkness. This is a central message of the Advent season, isn't it? God's light shines even when we don't see it burning brightly. We need to open our eyes and hearts to see it.

I remind you that we will gather around the table at Ocean Grill restaurant in Vero Beach on Wednesday, December 3, at Noon. RSVP with me. No guns, no threats of violence, just good times together. This is just one way that we "share the Light."

Finally, be thinking about what you will play (how you will share your light) for the Fifth Annual Christmas and Epiphany concert on January 4 at 4:00 PM at St. Mark's Anglican Church in Vero Beach. The church will provide a reception in the Parish Hall after the concert. There will be carol singing for all, so warm up your voice! Also, please NOTE THE SCHEDULE CHANGES for the season, as well as a very important announcement about Thomas Ingui, our guest artist in March. Read on!
