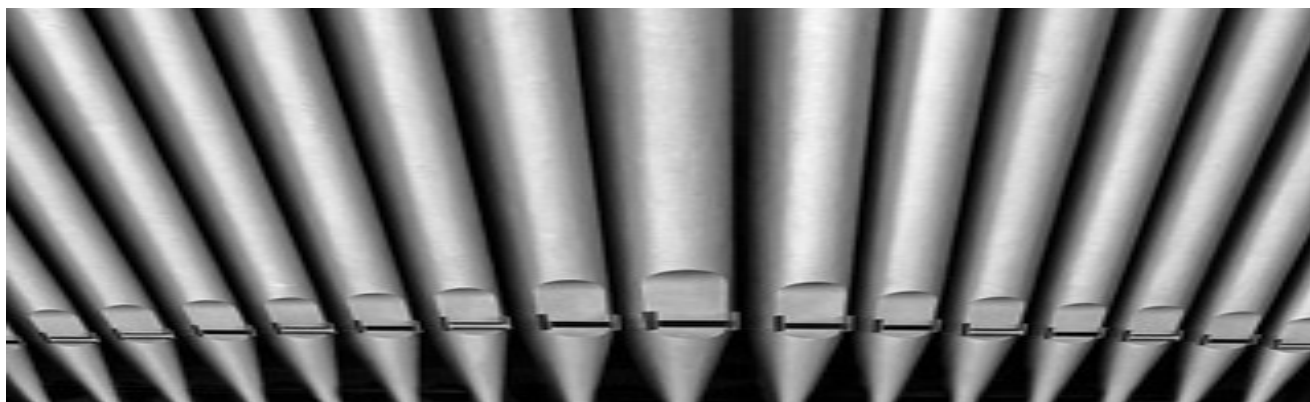
Interment will be at a later date in the columbarium of St. Paul's Cathedral in Buffalo, New York, where Don also served.

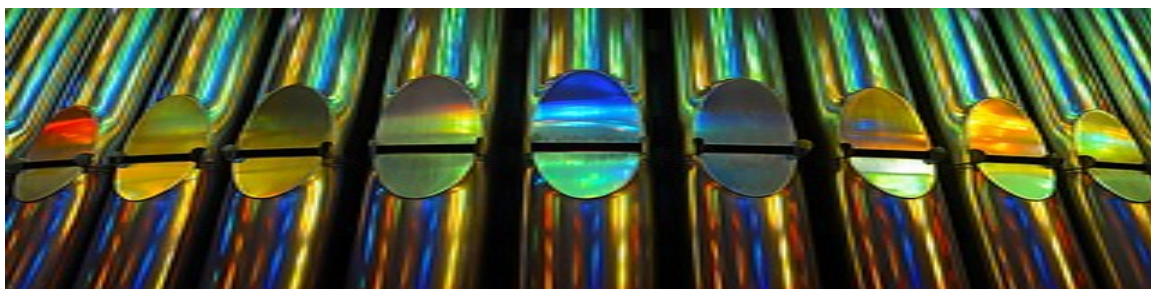

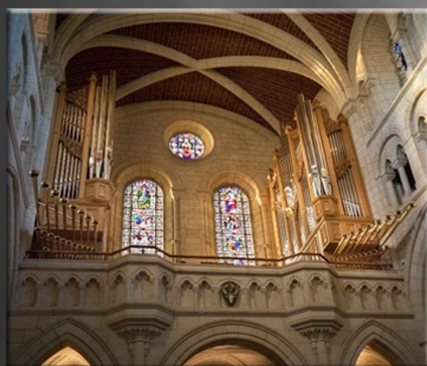

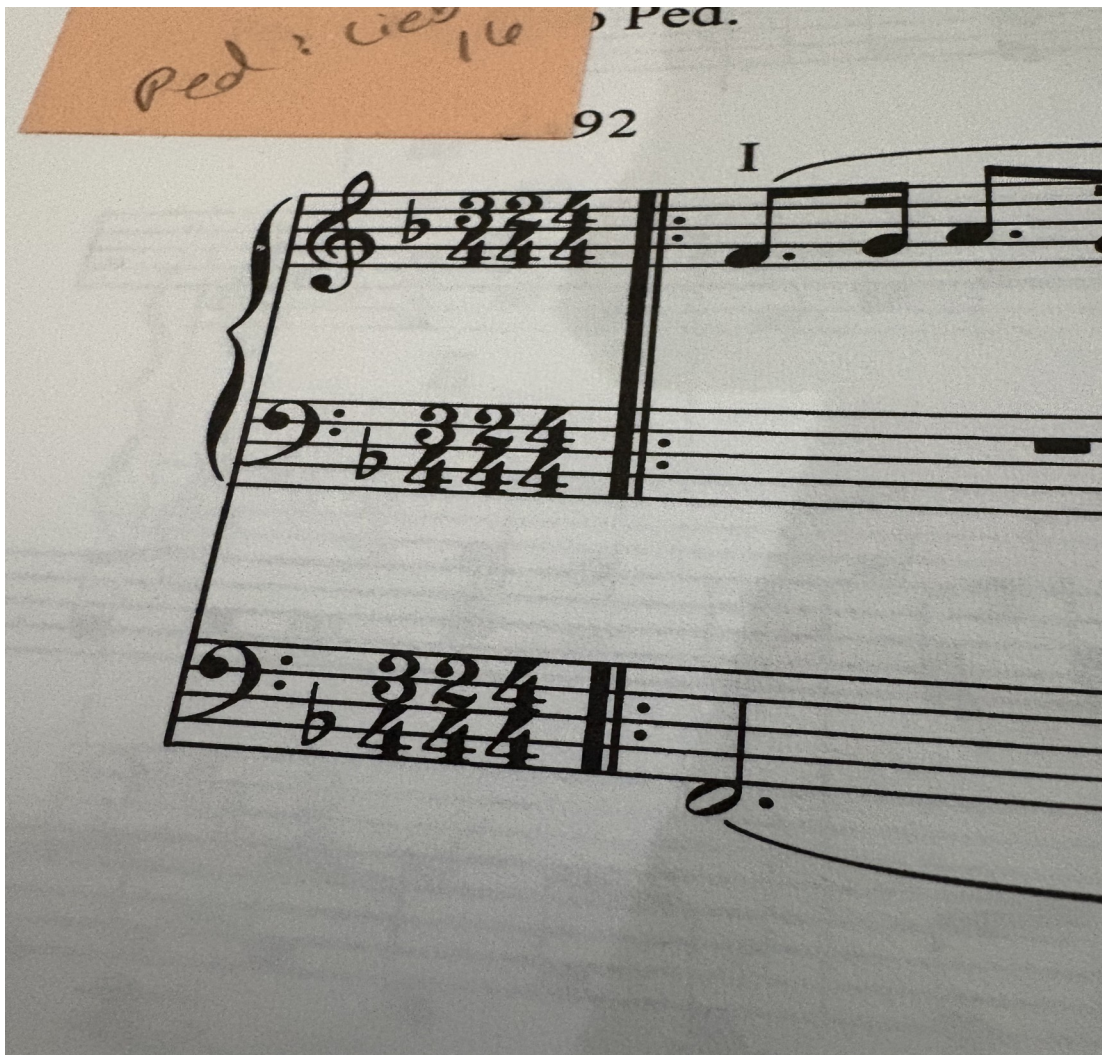
