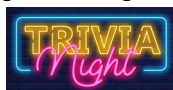
for his hard work in helping us achieve this. I have big shoes to fill.

Our next house committee is Monday, August 10th at 6:30 PM. We are always looking for more volunteers for many of our events and fresh ideas for future events.

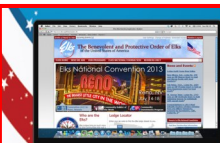

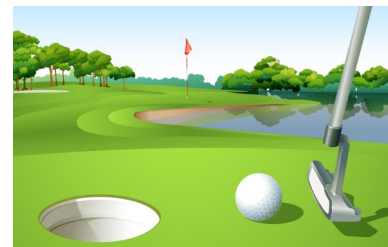
