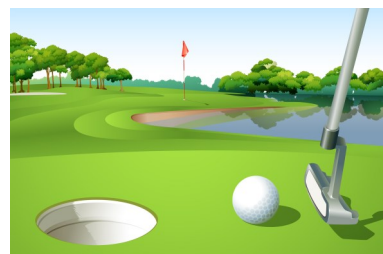

VETERAN'S COMMITTEE IN ACTION



Monday, August 17th, our lodge distributed the first Welcome Home Kit of the 2026-2027 Lodge year to a local veteran.

If you are wondering what a "Welcome Home Kit" is, we've included some information about them.

It is important to know that Elks give a hand up to veterans who were recently homeless by providing needed household supplies to help veterans establish their new homes.

These kits are made up of an array of items provided to a veteran moving into a new home to help them with day-to-day living.

Generally, a kit will include necessary items for kitchens, bathrooms, and bedrooms. We can provide bedding, dishes, towels, toiletries, cleaning supplies, laundry baskets, detergent, and more.

If lodges stay within the financial guidelines of Grand Lodge, local lodges are reimbursed for the cost of the kits, so we can provide these kits free of charge upon reimbursement.

You will also soon notice new signs for dedicated veteran parking around our Lodge parking lot. This is another small gesture to honor our veterans—especially those who are elderly or disabled—by providing convenient, designated parking spaces. Please be respectful of these spots.

We participate in the Feed Our Vets program every month at the Bruce Wright Memorial Conference Center, and we are always looking for extra hands to help out. Our volunteer date for September is **Saturday, September 19th at 9:00 a.m.**

Finally, I would like to report that we just completed a Welcome Home Kit for a veteran in need. Welcome Home Kits provide homeless veterans with the necessities of starting a new life in an apartment. This is a Grand Lodge-funded initiative, and we were proud to help our recipient get started on his new life.

Our next committee meeting will be held on **Tuesday, September 15th at 6:30 p.m.** The Veterans Committee is open to anyone interested in giving back to those who have courageously served our country. 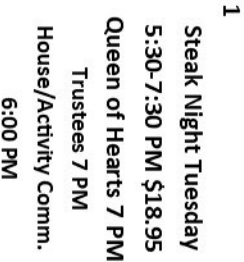
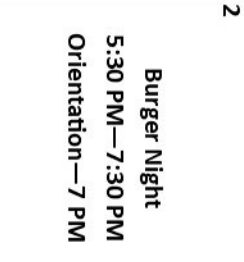
