The Financial Stretch

In the blink of an eye, the final stretch of the fiscal year is upon us. The ENF's 2022-23 fiscal year closes on March 31, and donations must be in the

ENF office by March 31 to count for the year. Any donations received after that date, regardless of postmark, will be counted toward the 2023-24 fiscal year.




