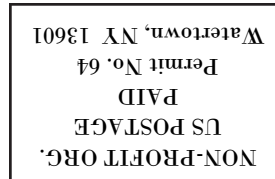

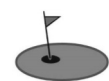

A member who continues to use such language after being asked to stop, will be asked to leave the premises by the bartender, Lodge Manager, or the Exalted Ruler.
