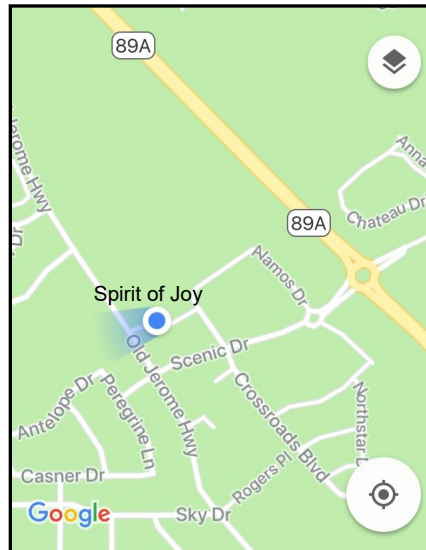

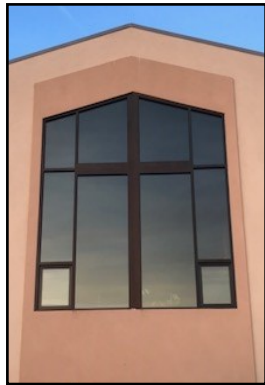

Our Commitment to the Community and Beyond

Spirit of Joy is a congregation dedicated to sharing our time, talents and finances to make a difference in the lives of others, whether it is here in our community or beyond.

If you like to be involved, there are ample opportunities to serve in our In-Reach/Outreach team activities such as:

Joy Packs is a program we started to help local "food insecure" students from area schools. During the school year we create packs of weekend food and deliver them to the schools to be shared with the students who need this ministry.

Annual Red Cross Blood Drive is held in November in honor of veterans.

Taste of Christmas is a yearly bake sale along with crafts and recycled holiday items. The women's group, WELCA, sponsors this event and raises funds at this one-day event for various social service organizations such as Navajo Mission School at Rock Point, Verde Valley Homeless Coalition and Luther Social Services of the SW.

Science and Religion Series occurs every Sunday in February with fascinating topics discussing the co-existence of Science and Religion.

Nationally and internationally we support the mission of the ELCA through their relief and hunger agencies.
