

### Summary:

This historical novel is based on the Siege of Leningrad (St. Petersburg) during World War II, and features several themes that explore what it means to overcome grief, issues surrounding identity and family, and the power of women's relationships. Winter Garden is a historical fiction novel by Kristin Hannah. It tells the story of the Whitson sisters, Meredith and Nina, and their mother, Anya. The book alternates between the past and present, and tells the story of Anya's life in war-torn Leningrad. Some say it's a heart-wrenching, historical book with a twist ending.
