TOUCH MATH NUMBER ACTIVITY

Little Pea

Touch Math is a program designed to help children learn numeral recognition & operations, and number representation through auditory, visual & tactile strategies.

- * Kids can play solo, using dried peas or pom poms to count 'n place on the board
- * Children can take turns calling out a number, and children find the correct numeral on their board, and fill it accordingly
- * Children begin with a full board (all numbers have correct amount of chips), and as the adult shows or calls out a number, children remove that number of chips from their board
- * Children scoop one handful of cotton balls and place them on empty spaces on their board. They then count how many empty spaces are left, and need to "grab" the correct amount. ("Not too much, not too little - right in the middle!")
- * Children either begin with a filled board, or an empty board. Children take turns spinning a number spinner, or a number die. The group adds/removes the corresponding amount from their own board

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
