PICTURE MATCHING ACTIVITY

Jack and the Beanstalk

We use this activity in either a large group, or smaller groups. The teacher or therapist can lead the activity. Children sit at a table with their master sheet and a glue stick in front of them, pointing to the corresponding image that the adult describes:

"I'm thinking of an animal that say 'mooooo'!"

Children then point to the image on their sheet (cow).

Variation 1:

Children then find the matching image from a field of images that are set next to them. They glue the matching image cut-out onto to their own sheet.

Variation #2:

One or two children act as "store owners" and keep all the cut-out pieces in front of them at a separate table(s). When their peers need to find the correct matching cut-out, they stand and walk to the store and ask the storeowner, "Do you have any ____?" Returning to their sheet, children glue on that matching cut-out.

Variation #3:

A child takes on the role of the adult by providing clues to their peers: "Look for someone who says, 'FE FI FO FUM!'"

When all the images on the master sheet are covered, children can glue a bean in the finished box!
