Selecting Goats at an Auction

Visual assessment is a key factor in successful goat breeding.

It involves identifying favourable and unfavourable traits in individual animals that impact the overall productivity of your herd.





Selecting Goats at an Auction Visual Assessment

<u>Head</u>

- •Head: Strong, with large, soft brown eyes, and a calm expression.
- •Nose: Slightly curved, wide nostrils
- •Mouth: strong, well-formed with well fitted jaw.
- •Forehead: Prominently curved, blending with the nose and horns.
- •Horns: Strong, moderately long, well-spaced, gradually curving backward, round, solid, dark in color.
- •Ears: Broad, smooth, medium length, hanging downward; short ears are undesirable.

Neck & Forequarters

- •Neck: Moderate length, well-fleshed, well-joined to forequarter.
- •Breastbone: Broad with a deep, broad brisket.
- •Shoulder: Fleshy, proportionate to body, well-fitted to withers.
- •Withers: Broad and well-fitted (not sharp).
- •Front Legs: Medium length, proportionate to body depth, strong, well-placed.
- •Pasterns: Strong joints, well-formed, dark hoofs.

Hindquarters

- •Rump: Broad, long, and not too sloped.
- •Buttocks: Well-fleshed, not flat.
- •Thighs: Fully fleshed.
- •Tail: Straight at the dock, may swing to either side.

Legs

- •Strong, well-placed, not too fleshy.
- •Strong legs indicate hardiness and a strong constitution, essential traits of the Kalahari Red.

Skin & Covering

- •Skin: Loose, supple with chest and neck folds (especially in rams).
- •Eyelids and hairless areas: Must be pigmented.
- •Tail area: 75% pigmentation required for studs, 100% ideal.
- Hair: Short & glossy

Reproductive Organs

Rams

- •Testicles: Large, even, with a distinct epididymis.
- •Acceptable: Split of up to 5cm.
- •Unacceptable: Too long, too small, too flat (no epididymis), long split, uneven or single testicles.

Does

- •Udder: Well-attached, even-shaped, and properly sized teats for lambs to suckle
- •This Udder: Should not hang too low or be uneven, with no tendency toward mastitis.
- •Teats: Should not be calabash-shaped.


Size

- •Ideal: Average-sized, heavy goat for maximum meat production.
- Leg to body ratio: Should be balanced at all ages.






