Our origins:

Decades ago, several CHS teachers, both active and retired, who were also CHS alumni, established the Alumni Association with the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to graduating seniors. Alumni-faculty such as Madelon K. Hickey, Dorothy Gilchrest, Miriam Biskin, Bea Poincel, Agnes Holleran, and many others have sustained the Association to help young Cohoesiers to attain their goals and dreams.

Our funding:

The Alumni Association is a non-profit organization that is funded entirely through donations and dues of CHS alumni. All of these monies are tax-deductible. In addition to simple payment of dues and donations, some alumni, their families, friends, or former students make a donation in memory/honor of a specified individual. Some choose to establish a scholarship in honor of an individual alumnus; these may be funded annually for a specified number of years, determined by the donor(s). Several years ago, the volunteers who comprise the Board of Directors decided to put the bulk of the scholarship/award funds into an interest bearing investment account in an effort to increase the longevity of the fund. At the current ratio of dues/donations to expenditures, the fund could be depleted in just a few years.
