Shipping Containers

Open Air Burning

No fires shall be set out of doors in the Township of Addington Highlands between the hours of 7am and 7pm from April 1st to October 31st. Campfires less than 1m in diameter are permitted at any time of the day providing there is no fire ban in place and you are only burning firewood. Please remember to keep water and a shovel nearby and never leave your fire unattended. Your fire is your responsibility. If it gets away, you are responsible for damages and any costs of putting it out.

Fire Rang

It is your responsibility to ensure there is no Fire Ban in effect and the conditions are safe and suitable for your fire.
