Dear Municipalities:

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has awarded a \$16,945,945 contract to Allan Myers of Worcester, Montgomery County, PA, to repair and resurface 28 state roadways in Delaware County.

Under this pavement improvement project, PennDOT will mill and resurface 45 miles of state highways in Delaware County using bituminous material. The new pavements will seal the roadways and provide motorists with a smoother riding surface.

The highways scheduled for resurfacing are:


- U.S. 13/Route 291 (2nd Street) between Penn Street and the Route 291 Bridge over Chester Creek in City of Chester;
- U.S. 202 (Wilmington Pike) between the Delaware State line and U.S. 1 (Baltimore Pike) in Concord and Chadds Ford townships;
- Route 352 (Edgmont Avenue) between 9th Street and Ridge Boulevard in Parkside and Brookhaven boroughs and City of Chester;
- Haverford Road between Winchester Road/Karakung Road and the Delaware County line in Haverford Township;
- Lawrence Road between Route 3 (West Chester Pike) and Eagle Road in Haverford Township;
- Cedar Grove Road between Route 252 (Newtown Street Road) and Route 320 (Sproul Road) in Marple and Newtown townships;
- Media Line Road between Route 252 (Newtown Street Road) and Route 3 (West Chester Pike) in Marple Township;
- Sugartown Road between Valley Forge Road and the Chester County line in Radnor Township;
- Brookline Boulevard between Darby Road and Earlington Road in Haverford Township;
- Calcon Hook Road between Hook Road and U.S. 13 (Chester Pike) in Sharon Hill Borough and Darby Township;
- Chester Road between Route 320 (Swarthmore Avenue) and Baltimore Pike in Swarthmore Borough;
- Hook Road between the Delaware County line and Calcon Hook Road in Darby Township;
- South Avenue between U.S. 13 (Chester Pike) and Franklin Avenue in Glenolden Borough and Ridley Township;

- Thompson Avenue between Baltimore Pike and Route 320 (Sproul Road) in Springfield Township;
- Victory Avenue between Route 3 (West Chester Pike) and the Victory Avenue Bridge over Cobbs Creek in Upper Darby Township;
- Flower Street/Edwards Street between 7th Street and the end of Edwards Road in the City of Chester;
- Ridge Road between the Delaware State line and Baker Street in Trainer Borough and Lower Chichester Township;
- Concord Road between Bethel Road and U.S. 1 (Baltimore Pike) in Aston, Concord, Chester, and Bethel townships;
- Dutton Mill Road between Route 452 (Pennell Road) and Route 352 (Edgmont Avenue) in Middletown and Aston townships and Brookhaven Borough;
- Wallingford Avenue between Manchester Avenue and Route 252 (Providence Road) in Nether Providence Township;
- Engle Street between 9th Street and Concord Road in Chester Township;
- Bodley Road between Valleybrook Road and Birney Highway in Aston Township and Chester Heights Borough;
- Highland Avenue between 15th Street and Bethel Road in City of Chester;
- Springlawn Road between Cheyney Road and Glen Mills Road in Concord and Thornbury townships;
- Cheyney Road between U.S. 1 (Baltimore Pike) and Creek Road in Thornbury and Concord townships;
- Thornton Road between Glen Mills Road and Cheyney Road in Thornbury Township;
- Thornton Road between Concord Road and Glen Mills Road in Thornbury and Concord townships; and
- Industrial Highway between Route 291 (Bartram Avenue) and the Philadelphia line in Tinicum Township.

Resurfacing operations will begin this summer and are expected to finish in summer 2024. This project is financed with 100 percent state funds.

Thank you for your interest and support of this important resurfacing project that maintains the department's transportation network and overall infrastructure in the Philadelphia region.
