EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The first quarter of 2026 reflects both strategic adaptation and continued growth across The Infnit™ Foundation’s initiatives. *Project Forevermore* expanded in scope following changes in the VR landscape, evolving beyond its original AI-driven film focus to also support the future of Eternity Chapel. This includes the development of a standalone application in Unreal Engine, designed for accessibility across mobile devices, VR headsets, smart TVs, and major consoles—establishing a more scalable and independent foundation for ministry and storytelling. Infnit™ Dominion will also continue development of its immersive virtual world experience.

Eternity Chapel experienced growth in both outreach and leadership. Three original worship songs—*Promised Land*, *Forsake It All*, and *Hundredfold*—were released across all major music marketplaces, extending worship beyond live services. Additionally, the election of two Elders and the appointment of a Women’s Ministry Director strengthen the church’s leadership and capacity for ministry. Development of *Book Three* of The Infnit™ Universe remains ongoing, with a commitment to faith-centered storytelling.

As we conclude the first quarter of 2026, I am grateful for the clarity, direction, and continued provision God has given to The Infnit™ Foundation. This season has brought both refinement and expansion—guiding us to build not only with creativity, but with resilience and long-term vision.

Project Forevermore: Expanding the Vision

In light of Meta’s recent announcement regarding the shutdown of VR access to Horizon Worlds, Project Forevermore has taken on a broader and more strategic role. What began as an AI-driven film initiative has now expanded to support the future of Eternity Chapel as well. This quarter marks a pivotal transition: Eternity Chapel is moving toward a fully standalone application, beautifully developed in Unreal Engine. This platform will be independent of Horizon Worlds and designed for wide accessibility across mobile devices, VR headsets, smart TVs, major consoles, and more.

Through this shift, we are not only adapting—we are building a stronger, more scalable foundation for ministry and storytelling moving forward.

Eternity Chapel: Growth in Worship and Leadership

Eternity Chapel continues to grow both spiritually and structurally. This quarter, three original worship songs—*Promised Land*, *Forsake It All*, and *Hundredfold*—were released across all major music marketplaces. What begins in live worship is continuing to extend outward, reaching individuals in their everyday lives.

In addition, the church has taken meaningful steps in leadership development. The congregation has elected two Elders to help share the responsibility of spiritual oversight, and a Women's Ministry Director has been appointed. These additions strengthen the church's ability to minister effectively while fostering deeper community and care within the body.

Development of Book Three of The Infnit™ Universe remains underway. As with each installment, this work is being approached with intentionality and prayer, ensuring that every element aligns with our mission to reflect truth through storytelling.

Progress continues on Infnit™ Dominion as we further develop its immersive virtual world. Each step brings us closer to a living, interactive world that merges creativity, narrative, and spiritual purpose.
