Ring Exchange

Officiant:

May these rings be a symbol of your unending love and faithful commitment to one another.

Partner 1 places ring on Partner 2's finger and says:

With this ring, I thee wed.

Partner 2 places ring on Partner 1's finger and says:

With this ring, I thee wed.

Pronouncement

Officiant:

By the power vested in me by the State of [**Officiant's State**],

I now pronounce you [**Husband & Wife**].

You may now kiss [**the Bride**]
