

Use this procedure for all artificail nail applications.

Nail Preparation

- 1. Use normal wash and sanitize procedures for hands.
- 2. Remove Polish or any other products or material from the natural nail bed.
- 3. Gently push back the cuticle and remove cuticle (pterygium) from the nail plate.
- 4. Remove the shine from the nail plate using a medium to fine grit file or buffer. Use a forward and back motion from the cuticle area to the free-edge and remove shine and moisture from the natural nail plate.
- 5. Remove the filing dust from the nail plate. A manicure brush will work the best.
- 6. Apply a coat of *Nail Prep Dehydrator/ Balance* to the natural nail. This will cleanse and prep the surface of the nail plate.
- 7. Apply *Fusion/Bonder* non-acid primer for adhesion of acrylic. The Bonder will work in approximately 30 seconds and have a continued wet "look" or appearance.
- 8. Apply *nail forms* or *nail tips* to the nails.

Proceed with regular artificial nail application.
