Read John 8. Here is one of Jesus' brilliant discussions with the Jews concerning the matter of truth. All truth is found in Jesus (see John 14:6). In Jesus a person is introduced to what truth really is. This truth makes someone free (verses 34-36). Verses 42-47 give Jesus' judgment upon the lie and upon the people who speak lies.
As you reflect on the world you live in, think of the lies that are seen in advertising, in corruption of cities, in power. Lies are all around us. See how often in this chapter Jesus says, "I tell you the truth." Jesus is indeed The Way, The Truth, and The Life (John 14:6).
