- ◆ Bible Passages—know the following Bible passages covering the Sacrament of Holy Communion, The Office of the Keys & Worship.
  - 1. John 6:35 "I Am the bread of life; whoever comes to Me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in Me shall never thirst."
  - 2. 1 Corinthians 10:16 "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?" (#1092)
  - 3. 1 Corinthians 11:26 "As often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes." (#1136)
  - **4. Galatians 2:20** "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." (#1031)
