

2021 MATCH RULES

1. Maximum number of anglers to attend a club match is 30.
2. Anglers must book into matches and are accepted on a first come first served basis. No one is automatically on the list apart from the match organiser.
3. Names for matches will **NOT** be taken until the day after the previous match.
4. Match draw will take place on the day before the match live on Facebook and participants will be notified of their peg number by text message.
5. If you draw a peg number with an asterisk (*) you are to help with the weigh in (either on scales or weigh sling). If someone is unable to help due to health reasons the next peg in that section will take their place in helping.
6. Lambourne net limits: Silvers net plus maximum of 3 carp nets. Nets have a limit of 50lbs, anything between 50-60lbs doesn't count and if the net is over 60lbs the whole net is disqualified. If in the unlikely event you fill all your carp nets then please rotate placing fish in each net to try to keep them as equal as possible.
7. Beauchamps net limits: Net for any fish under 1lb and another net for 1lb+ fish. 50lb limit applies.
8. This season points will be awarded to your final place in your section rather than the whole match. Your best 6 results will go towards the Summer and Winter league and both leagues will be added together for the Matchman of the year award.
9. Members will have priority over guests when booking into matches. If you are unable to attend a match you are booked in for please let the match organiser know as there could be a waiting list.
10. When arriving at your peg please lay out your nets, nets are NOT allowed to enter the water until 15 minutes before the start of the match.
11. Please be mindful when parking, our car parks will be full at club matches and cars need to be parked sensibly.
12. Please put match pools in envelopes supplied and write your name on it and place into plastic box supplied.
13. At Beauchamps any king carp caught over 5lbs will count as 5lbs and need to be witnessed and put back.
14. During Covid no one is to follow the scales around the lake, please return to your vehicle once you've weighed in.
