UNWANTED GUEST IN BEAUCHAMPS

Would just like to share this with you. A few weeks ago, member Toby Briton caught a small Zander from peg 33 Beauchamp's Fishery on worm bait. First of all we have no permission to keep Zander in any fishery we have, secondly the EA do not give permission to hold them. It has been suggested that the fish may have come in a shipment of fish; however recent additions to Beauchamp's have been from reputable fish breeders who do not have Zander in their stocks. The fish that was caught was only small about $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ lb and would be much bigger now from any stock fish we had from 3 years ago or more from private fisheries. If a member has transferred this fish from another venue it is totally irresponsible and if any illegal imports of fish happens again and we catch the member responsible they will be immediately expelled from the club.



If the Zander is caught in the future it must be removed and destroyed humanely.
