

# **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING BALLOT RESULTS**

Of the 275 ballot papers sent out to members, 89 were returned, just over 32% of membership.

All Committee nominees were returned to look after the club on behalf of the members and all propositions were carried.

### Election of Officers as per Ballot paper

On the vote for Committee For 88 Against 1 Abstain 0

#### **Changes to rules**

Rules 2.1 For 88 Against 1 Abstain 0

Election to membership of the committee shall be by postal ballot and/or of those members of the Society present at the Annual General Meeting ......to continue.

Rule 2.6 For 86 Against 1 Abstain 1

The Constitution and Rules of the Society may be amended by a postal ballot and/or of those members of the Society present at the Annual General Meeting ......to continue.

Rule 5.21 For 51 Against 33 Abstain 2

The use of boilies, all beans, nuts and peas as ground bait or hook bait is not permitted

Rule 6.11 For 85 Against 2 Abstain 2

(A) Lambourne's net rule, maximum of 3 carp nets plus one silvers net. 50lb limit per net, anything between 50 – 60lb gets knocked back to 50lb. Any net over 60lb will be disqualified unless all 3 carp nets are up to their limit in which case you can alternate between the nets trying to keep them even as possible.

(B) Beauchamp's net rule, all fish under 11b in one net and all fish over 11b in a separate net.

50lb limit per net, anything between 50 – 60lb gets knocked back to 50lb.

Any net over 60lb will be disqualified.

Rule 6.14 For 87 Against 2 Abstain 0

No sponsored angler may participate in club matches other than those who became sponsored whilst being a member.

Rule 7.1 For 81 Against 8 Abstain 0

Fees increased by £5, Adult £70, adult aged 65 with 5 years membership and joined before 2018 £55, those aged 65 and joined after 2018 £70, Juniors remain at £5.

These results will appear as amendments in your new membership book.

### FISH DELIVERY AT BEAUCHAMPS

We have received a fish delivery to our Beauchamp's Fishery from Jon Wall Fisheries Ltd, which consisted of  $300 \times 6$ " to 8" Bream and  $200 \times 6$ " to 8" Ide. These all went to the main lake.

A further  $100 \times 4$ " to 6" crucian carp and 10 bream of about 2lbs went into the small lake.

These were all healthy quality fish and were from a fish breeder we have used and trusted in the past. Our thanks go out to all members who have made donations during the year. Without your generosity stocking fish of this quantity and quality would not be possible.
