Fish Fund

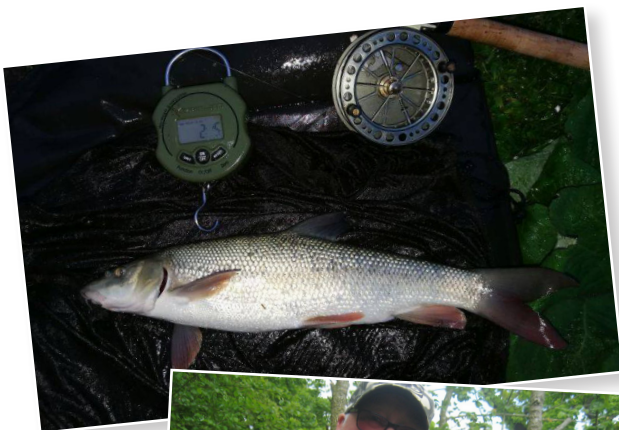

A solar powered aeration system has been installed in the small lake at Beauchamps and is now under evaluation, with data already gathered, it appears to meet our requirements and another may be installed in the main lake.

Fishing continues to be very good at both fisheries, plenty of carp being caught at Lambourne, however we do not seem to get any photographs coming through and lots of really good fish at Beauchamps. The large bream have now been moved to the main lake and are doing well. There are still plenty of big fish in the small lake. Some really exceptional barbel have been caught in the main lake, several in the 4lbs+ range.
