A hunt is underway in Ayr for a vulnerable 57 year old woman who's gone missing from Ailsa Hospital. Annalisa Landymore-Lim disappeared around 1 o'clock yesterday afternoon.

She takes regular medication and Police don't think she has it with her.

She is described as 5ft 6 tall, slim build with brown curly permed hair and blue eyes. When last seen she was wearing black trousers, black zipper top, black walking boots and was carrying a black ruck sack. Inspector Brian Anderson at Ayr Police Office said:

"Annalisa is currently receiving treatment within Ailsa Hospital and uses medication on a daily basis. As time passes we believe that she does not have access to the medication and therefore we are becoming increasing concerned for her safety and wellbeing.

From Lisa:

I ran away walking over 22 miles at night leaving Ailsa Hospital the former asylum in Ayr because I didn't want to be forcibly injected. I was not taking any medication at the time because I had refused to take any, so I was not 'using medication on a daily basis'. I suspect that the hospital staff lied to the police to try to make it seem as though I urgently needed help when I was in fact totally normal. The injections and drugs for 7.5 years left me lying on a bed or couch most of the time and have ruined my health. I am only 5ft 1in with straight hair and brown not blue eyes.
