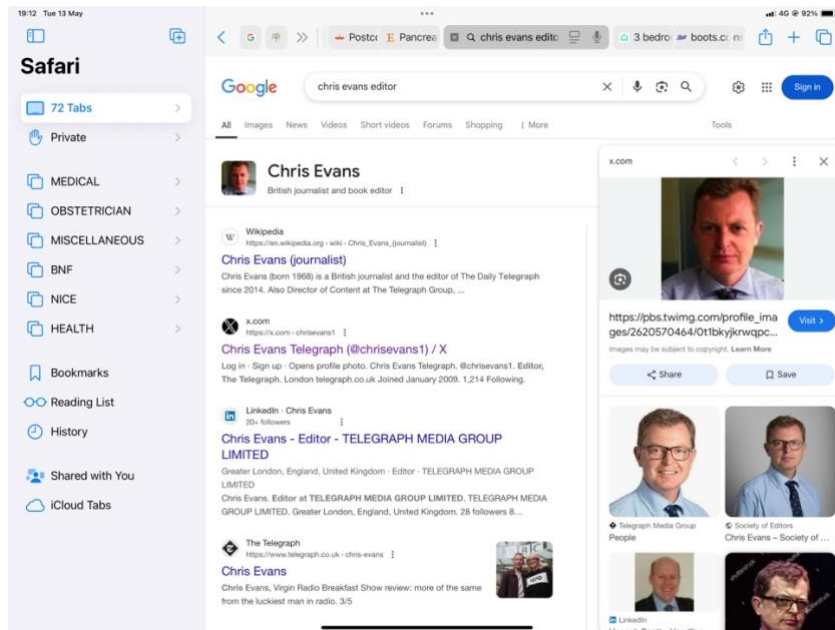

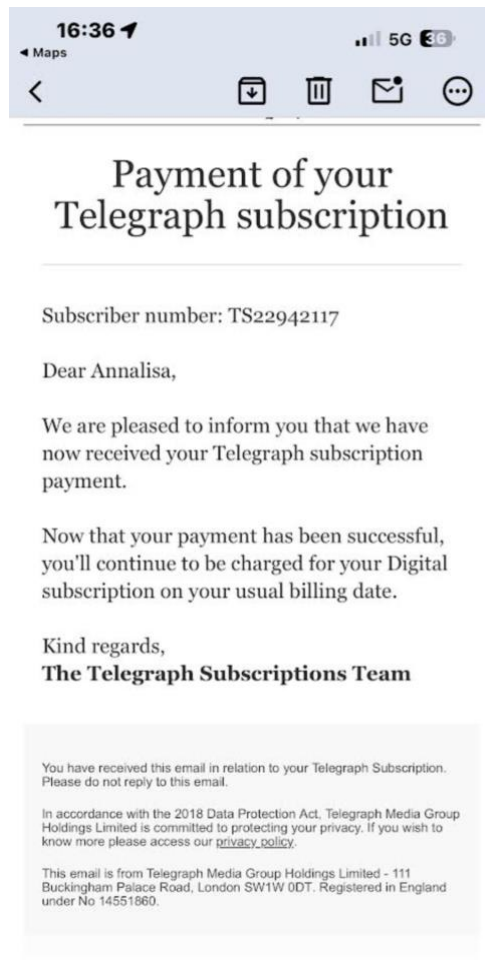

The Telegraph Newspaper owes me about £200 for illegally debiting my bank account for EIGHT MONTHS and despite repeated requests to the Editor Chris Evans shown below, nothing was done until October 2024.
