Esther's Viognier

Esther's Viognier is a delicious light dry white wine with notes of honeysuckle, apricot, and pairs delightfully well with spicy food - like curries and chilis! This wine is dedicated to all the fun-loving aunts out there and the epitome partying aunt- Sarah's Great Aunt Esther (who passed away at 106 in 2021). No matter her age, Esther was always partying the night away, and when the bar was closing she would call out that it was "only the shank of the evening!" -aka dusk. No matter of the time - she is always up for a good wine, and Viognier was her favorite! So make sure to toast the New Years with Esther's Viognier, and party like a centenarian!



Grant Girl Wine Collection

Esther's Viognier is the first release from our Grant Girl Wine Collection, a series of three wines dedicated to Sarah's grandmother, Nelle, and her two sisters, Gene and Esther. When Sarah and Colton bought the winery, they promised to make a wine for each of these special ladies and now it is happening! All three sisters passed away last year, and all at impressive ages: Nelle (99), Esther (106), and Gene (104). Make sure to keep an eye out in the next couple of months for Nelle's "What a Hoot!" Semi-Sweet Red Blend and Gene's "Passion of the Times" Blush!

Dry White Merlot 2021

Did you help us harvest in August 2021? If you did, your wine is done! Charron Vineyard's signature wine - Dry White Merlot 2021- is ready and delicious! It is a crisp and light fruit forward wine with a slight aroma of guava and notes of apricot. I can hear you asking, how do you make a white Merlot? Well, to make a red Merlot you macerate the juice of the grapes with the red skins of a Merlot berry. To make a white Merlot, we separate the red skins and ferment just the juice - which creates a beautiful blush color and unique taste. If you are interested in learning more about how we make our wine, make sure to volunteer to help with our 2022 harvest, which will be approximately the first weekend in August.

Sidewalk Chalk Art Drop-In Event Sat Jan 22 (12-4pm)

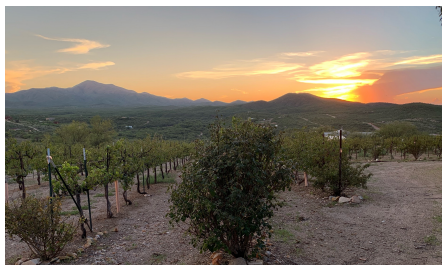
