

The Nanticoke Valley Historical Society is pleased to announce that local quilter and Town of Maine resident, Linda Austin, will be teaching a 5-week class in quilting on Wednesday evenings this August.

## *Steps to a Happy Quilting Project*

1. Sign up to attend the **5 sessions: Wednesdays, August 3, 10, 17, 24 and 31**. Classes will be held from 6-8 PM. You will receive more information and directions once you have registered for the class. You can sign up online by **clicking a link below**. The cost for the 5-week class is \$30 for NVHS members and \$35 for non-members. This class is being offered exclusively to NVHS members until June 20, 2022 when registration will be open to the public.
2. Decide what you want your finished project to look like (see some examples below)
  - Pillow or Wall Hanging
  - Theme for your project: Flowers, Hearts, Houses, Stars, or Trees
  - Fabric colors you want to use
3. Purchase the needed supplies (fabric, thread, acrylic ruler, scissors, seam ripper) A complete list of materials will be provided to you upon registration.
4. Come and join the fun as we work together for 5 Sessions – each class will last about 2 hours.
  - Session 1 – August 3: Introductory info, Cutting and Sewing your 9 Patch Blocks
  - Session 2 – August 10: Applique Block – Machine Applique or Hand Applique
  - Session 3 – August 17: Paper Piecing
  - Session 4 – August 24: Assembling your Quilt Sandwich and Quilting
  - Session 5 – August 31: Completing your Pillow or Wall Hanging
