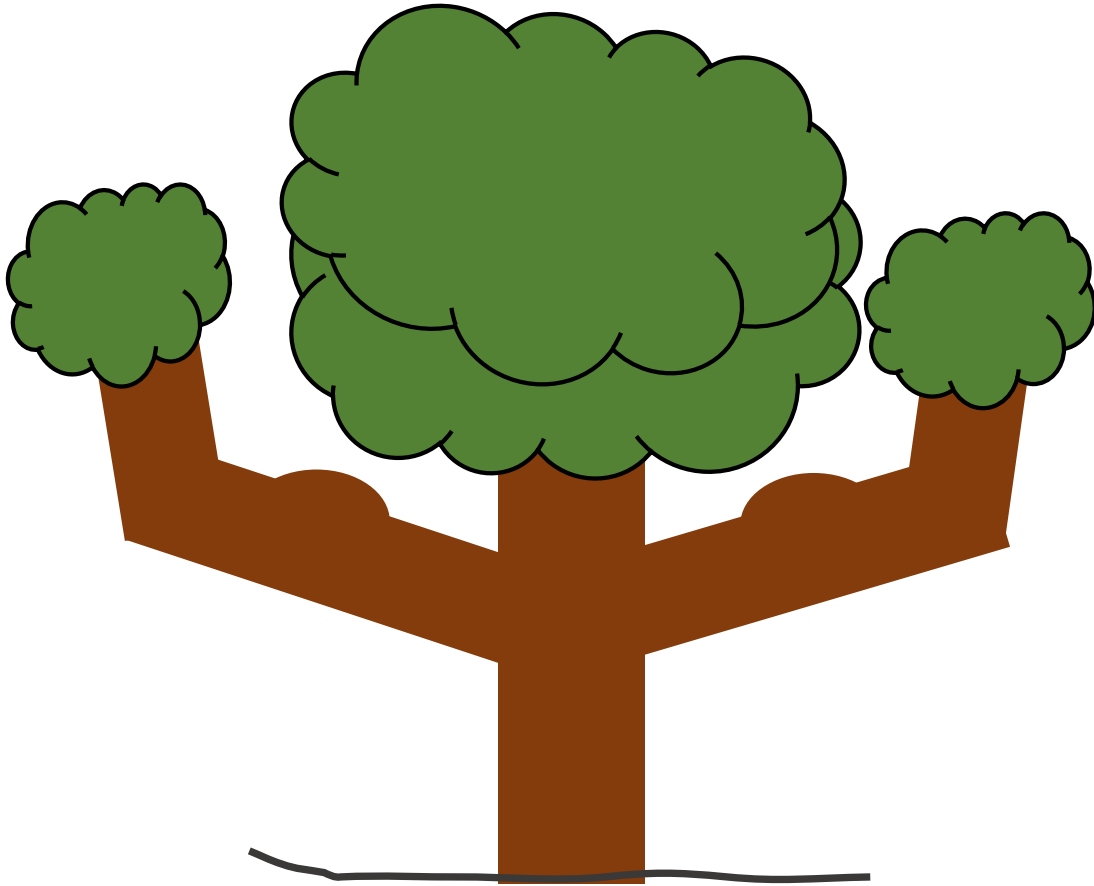


Town of Maine Largest Tree Contest

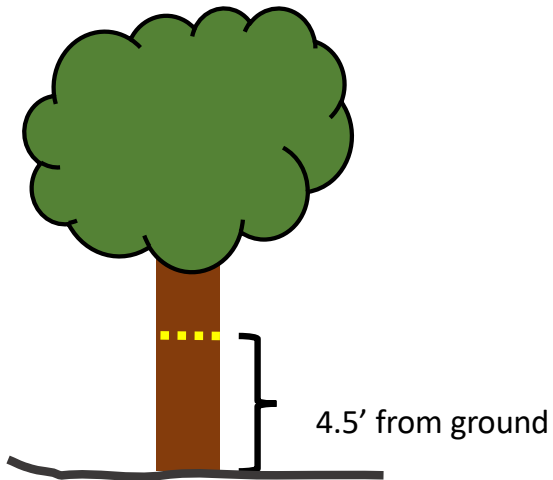


Do you have a champion tree?

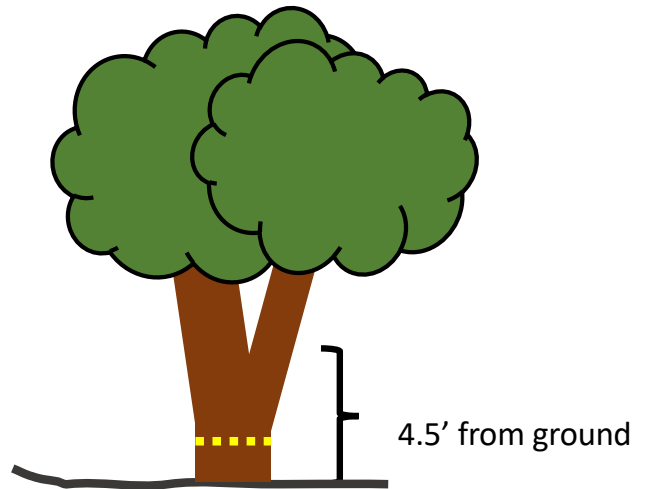
1. Enter your tree at <https://forms.gle/w1UzXqRH1T4bz2nv8>
 2. Send a picture of your tree to: greenspacenvhs@gmail.com
- Tree must be located in the Town of Maine and native to the region.
 - Winner is based on circumference of the trunk at 4 ½ feet from ground. (see page 2 for measuring guidelines).
 - Two categories: Private Land and Public Land
 - On private land, you must own the land where the tree is located
 - On public land, the person that submits the entry first will be the winner.
 - Champions for each species and each category will be recognized on the Nanticoke Valley Historical Society website, earn a certificate, and have bragging rights until dethroned by a larger tree.
 - All entries must be received by August 31st.

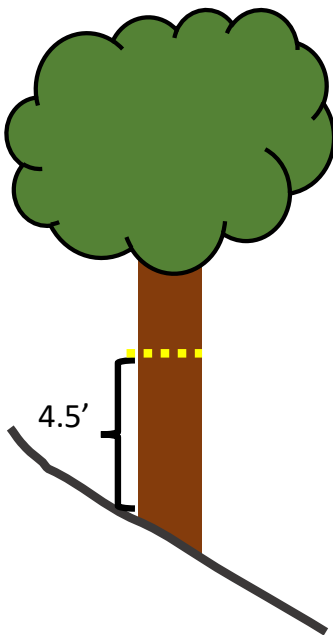
Measuring your Town of Maine Champion tree:



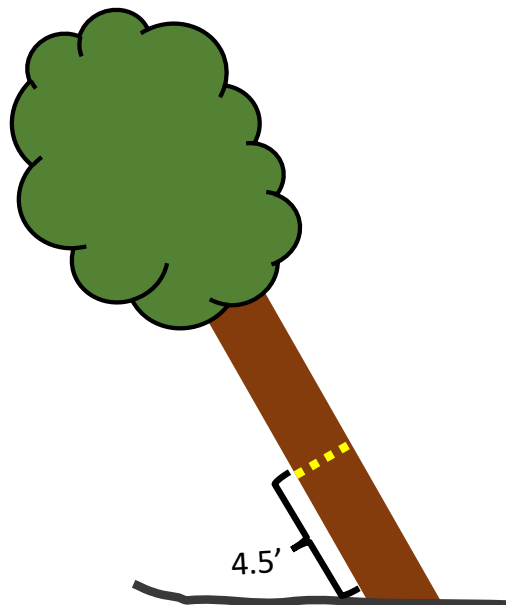
In normal case,
measure circumference
at 4.5' feet above the
ground.



If tree forks below 4.5', measure
narrowest point below the fork
and indicate distance from
ground.



If tree is on a slope, measure
from the uphill side.



If tree leans, measure up from
direction it leans. Still measure
perpendicular to height.
