Congratulations **Marie Roberts** on making front page news of Courier. Recognition is so well deserved for a lady who gives her all to commitment.

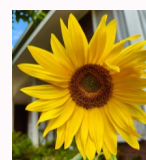

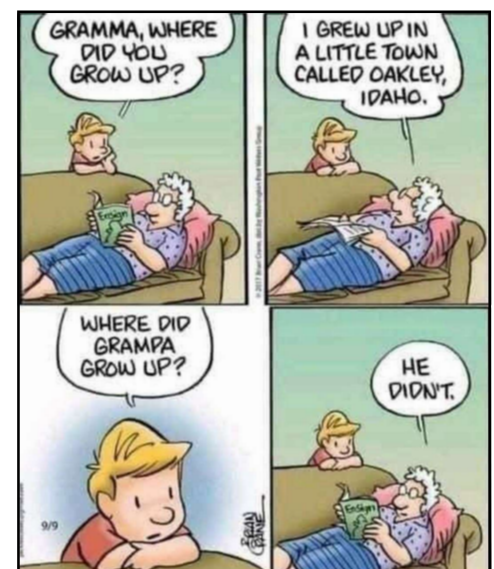

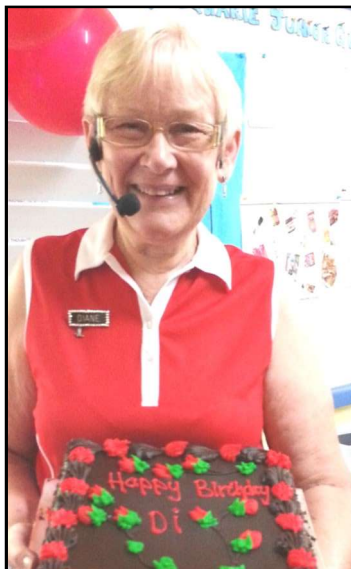
Most people are at the age where they are using their phones to document the good times in their lives.

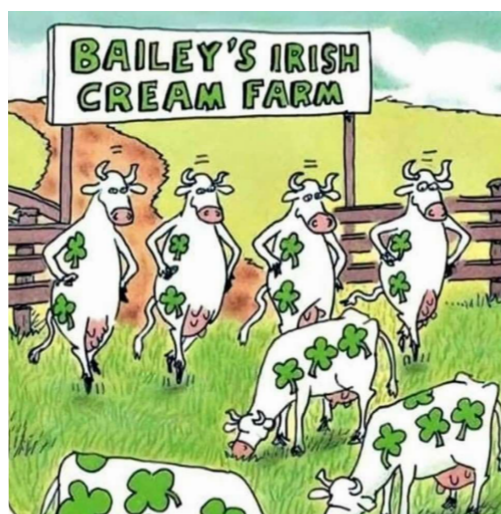
