Product Overview



BuzzCaps are compatible with most 4" & 5" vinyl posts and can be installed in just minutes.

4" Post Installation

Each BuzzCap comes with a 4" adapter already attached. To install on a 4" post, first remove any existing post cap and set aside. (Note: You may need to use a small flat head screwdriver if PVC glue was used with your existing fence caps. Apply firm but consistent pressure to the fence cap to remove, being

careful not to damage the cap or the post). Next, simply slide the 4" adapter onto the post.






4" adapter from the BuzzCap and set aside.

5" Post Installation

To install on a 5" post, first remove any existing post cap and set aside. (Note: You may need to use a small flat head screwdriver if PVC glue was used with your existing fence caps. Apply firm but consistent pressure to the fence cap to remove, being careful not to damage the cap or the post). Next remove the

Item A - Recessed Spaces for 4" adapter



Insert the interior 5" channel into the 5" vinyl post by angling it slightly and pressing it firmly into place.

Expect some resistance, as this is how the BuzzCap stays in position so securly.

Temperature can impact plastics in a significant way, if you encounter too much resistance inserting the BuzzCap, wait until the temperature differential between the BuzzCap and the post has normalized.

Torch Instructions:

Always remove the canister from the BuzzCap prior to filling with oil and ensure no oil has spilled on the BuzzCap or surrounding area before lighting. Do not fill the torch canister beyond ¾ full and keep the wick as short as possible to reduce soot and smoke. ALWAYS USE CLEAN BURNING OIL. DO NOT LEAVE FIRE UNATTENDED AND KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. DO NOT BURN TORCHES IN HIGH WINDS.

BuzzCaps are not intended for use near walls or other flammable materials. Always check the surrounding area to ensure the torch flame cannot reach or heat flammable materials.
