NARRATIVE SUMMARY:

EXTERNAL DESCRIPTION: This is the body of a white female whose appearance is consistent with the stated age of 30 years. The height is approximately 5 feet 6 inches and weight is approximately 160 pounds. The scalp hair is long and brown with streaks of gray and is tangled and matted in some areas. The irides are blue and the pupils measure 4 mm. in diameter bilaterally. The upper and lower teeth are natural and in a fair state of repair. The ear canals, nostrils, and oral cavity are unremarkable. No petechial hemorrhages are present involving the conjunctivae. The face is plethoric. No facial fractures or skull fractures are palpable. The neck shows no evidence of hypermobility on manipulation and no bruises, lacerations, or pressure marks are seen involving the skin of the neck. The chest is unremarkable. The breasts are unremarkable. No rib fractures or sternal fractures are seen. Examination of the abdomen reveals a pressure pattern consistent with the ceramic tiles of the floor of the bathroom on which she was found. This pattern is present largely on the left side of the abdomen. There is no evidence of organomegaly or masses. The genitalia are of an unremarkable female. Examination of the upper extremities reveals a 3/4 inch recent bruise involving the medial aspect of the right upper arm. A few strands of hair are present in the palm of the right hand and this hair is consistent with the hair of the decedent. A "bracelet" of hair is present around the palm and fingers of the left hand and is consistent with the hair of the decedent. The hands and nails are otherwise unremarkable. No fractures or dislocations of the upper extremities are seen. No needle marks are seen. Vaginal speculum exam is unremarkable. A few recent appearing bruises are present on the medial aspect of the bilateral upper thighs. The lower extremities are otherwise unremarkable except for the presence of a clump of hair, consistent with that of the decedent, between the toes of the left foot. Examination of the back, anus, and buttocks is unremarkable. Speculum examination (report continues on next page)

of the anus is unremarkable.

Swabs of the vaginal secretions and anus are taken to rule out the presence of sperm.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION: The usual Y-shaped incision is made. The subcutaneous tissues, adipose tissues, and musculature appear normally hydrated. No fractures or dislocations are present. All organs are normally present within the thoracic, abdominal, and pelvic cavities. No hemorrhages or effusions are present involving any body cavity. There is no evidence of pulmonary embolism. The pericardial sac is unremarkable.

ORGAN WEIGHTS: Heart - 429 grams

Right Lung - 842 grams Left Lung - 677 grams Liver - 1525 grams Spleen - 247 grams

Right Kidney - 254 grams Left Kidney - 281 grams Brain - 1307 grams

NECK: No hemorrhages are present involving the subcutaneous tissues, soft tissues, or musculature of the neck. The hyoid bone and cartilages of the trachea and larynx are intact and show no evidence of fracture. No petechial hemorrhages are seen on the epiglottis or larynx. The oral pharynx, nasal pharynx, thyroid gland, and tongue are unremarkable. No obstruction of the upper respiratory airways is seen. The carotid sheaths are unremarkable bilaterally. No evidence of cervical fracture or dislocation is seen.

HEART: The coronary arteries are normal in size, caliber, and distribution with no evidence of significant atherosclerosis, obstruction, or thrombosis. There is no evidence of right ventricular hypertrophy, although a moderate degree of concentric left ventricular hypertrophy is present. On cut sectioning, the myocardium does not show evidence of mottling or scarring. The cardiac valves are unremarkable, and the in-flow and out-flow tracks of the heart appear unremarkable. The great vessels are unremarkable. The aorta does not show evidence of significant atherosclerosis.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: The lungs are heavily congested bilaterally but are otherwise unremarkable. There is no evidence of frank consolidation or pulmonary fibrosis. The bronchial tree contains a small amount of liquid vomitus bilaterally, but is otherwise unremarkable. There is no evidence of pulmonary embolism.

DIAPHRAGM: Unremarkable.

LIVER AND BILIARY SYSTEM: The liver has a normal color but shows slight blunting of the margins suggestive of fatty metamorphosis of mild to moderate degree. There is no evidence of fibrosis or cirrhosis. The gallbladder and biliary system are unremarkable.

GASTROINTESTINAL SYSTEM: The esophagus and stomach are unremarkable. The stomach contains only a small amount of clear brown fluid. The large and small bowel are unremarkable. The appendix is unremarkable.

SPLEEN: Unremarkable.

URINARY SYSTEM: The kidneys are unremarkable externally and on cut sectioning, and the renal pelves, ureters, and bladder are unremarkable.

UTERUS, FALLOPIAN TUBES, AND OVARIES: Unremarkable with no evidence of pregnancy or any abnormality.

ADRENAL GLANDS: Unremarkable.

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM: The usual intermastoid incision is made and the scalp is reflected. No subgaleal hemorrhages are present. No skull fractures are present. There is no evidence of epidural, subdural, or subarachnoid hemorrhage. The brain shows no evidence of trauma. The brain shows no evidence of significant natural disease externally or on cut sectioning. The vasculature at the base of the brain is unremarkable. The brain does not appear to be swollen.

POSTERIOR NECK DISSECTION: Unremarkable.

CERVICOTHORACIC SPINAL CORD: Unremarkable.
