Day 1 — Arrive + Travel to Uvita

Day 3 — Turtle Patrol + Wildlife Walk

Early morning turtle patrol experience, followed by birding and wildlife with a local guide.



Day 4 — Sierpe Mangrove Boat Tour

Mangrove wildlife boat tour through the Sierpe wetlands, with lunch included.



Day 5 — Uvita Flex Day

A slower day to rest, explore, beach walk, bird, or enjoy optional local activities or additional turtle patrols.



Day 6 — Manuel Antonio National Park

Private shuttle to Manuel Antonio, guided national park tour, and included group dinner.



Day 7 — Beach Day or Optional Tour Day

Relaxed beach day with chairs and a stocked cooler provided, or choose an optional local tour.



Day 8 — Departure

Private shuttle from Manuel Antonio to SJO airport.
