RULES.

All Handicrafts and Cookery should be the unaided work of the exhibitor. There will be an entry fee of £1 for all entries, except for the Young People's Classes, which are 50p. You may enter as many times as you wish in each class. Proceeds from the entry fee will be divided 50/50 between Lufton Church and the prize money for each class. The judges may award or withhold prizes at their discretion.

Entries should be brought to Lufton Church on Saturday 15th. August at 12.30.p.m. Judging will commence at 1.00.p.m. Prizes will be awarded at 2.30.p.m. and entries can be removed at 3.00.p.m.

Class 1. A Pot Plant or house plant.

Class 2. An arrangement of flowers and/or foliage, maximum space not to exceed 45 cms. (18 ins.) in any direction.

Class 3. A Photograph, depicting 'The Natural World'.

Class 4. A drawing or painting, in any media, any subject.

Class 5. A piece of textile handcraft, sewing, knitting, embroidery, etc.

Class 6. Any other handcraft or hand-made article.

Class 7. A plate of 6 small cakes, scones, biscuits or tray bake. (The plate should be covered with cling film.)

Class 8. A jar of home-made jam, jelly, curd, or chutney.

YOUNG PEOPLES' CLASSES.

Entry Fees are 50p for all entries for Classes 9 to 17. You may enter as many times in each class as you wish.

Classes 9 to 12 are for those up to School Year 6 at the Show date. Please indicate age on each entry.

Class 9. A monster, animal, or insect, made of vegetables and/or fruit.

Class 10. A hand-made greeting or birthday card.

Class 11. An arrangement of flowers in a jam jar.

Class 12. A model, made of Lego.

Classes 13 to 17 for those in School Year 7 and above at the Show date.

Class 13. A picture or drawing in any media, of any subject.

Class 14. An arrangement of flowers and/or foliage in an unusual container, maximum space allowed 25 cms. (10 ins.) in any direction.

Class 15. A photograph to illustrate 'A Summer Day'.

Class 16. Any model, made from Lego or from a Kit.

Class 17. A plate of four cakes, scones, biscuits or tray bake. (The plate should be covered with cling film.)
