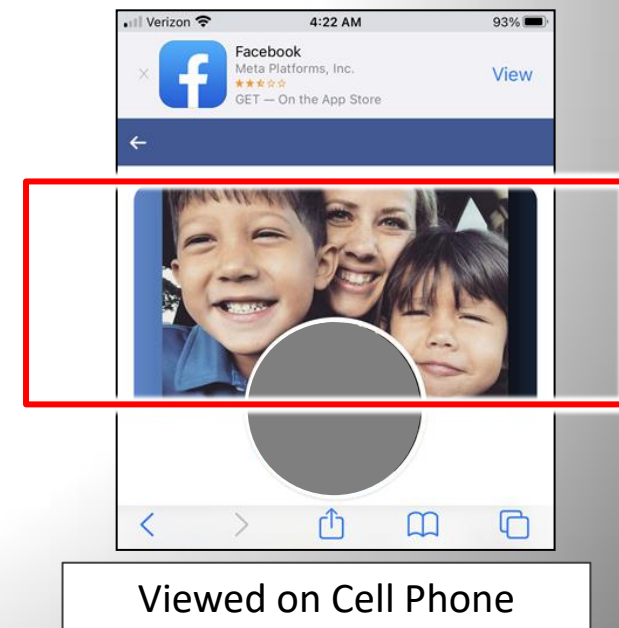
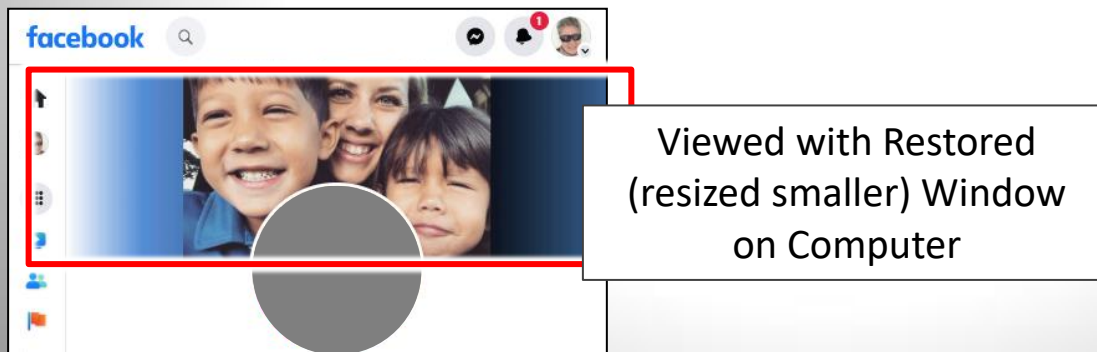
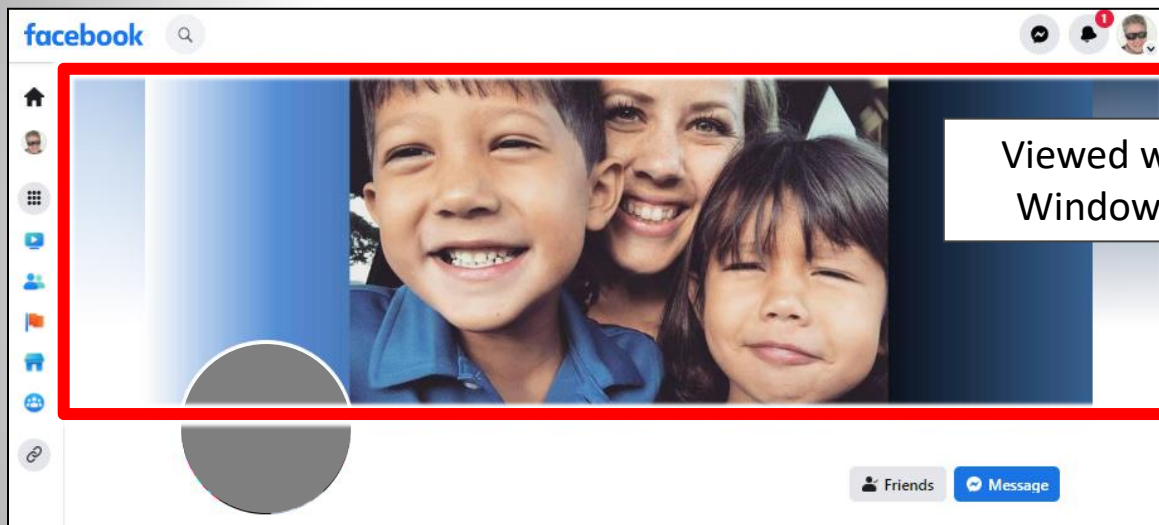
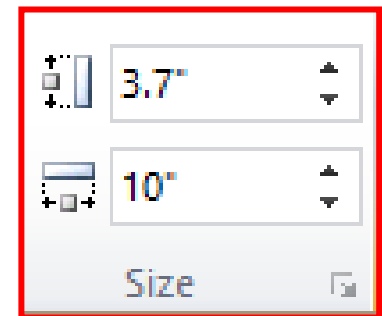


# How to Make Your Facebook Page Cover Photos Fit Nicely in the Wide Rectangle





- 1) Create a container (box shape) that is 3.7" (H) x 10" (W).
  - The container can be "invisible" in the end product by selecting box format options: "No Line" and "No Fill."
  - The container above is a box with a gradient fill and no line.
- 2) Insert your pictures and text to fit within the container.
- 3) Group all the elements together.
- 4) Right-click on the Grouped picture and select "Save as Picture."
- 5) In the File Type field, select "JPG" for file format.

### Your Page's **profile picture**:

- Displays at 176x176 pixels on your Page on computers, 196x196 pixels on smartphones and 36x36 pixels on most feature phones.
- Is cropped to a circle.

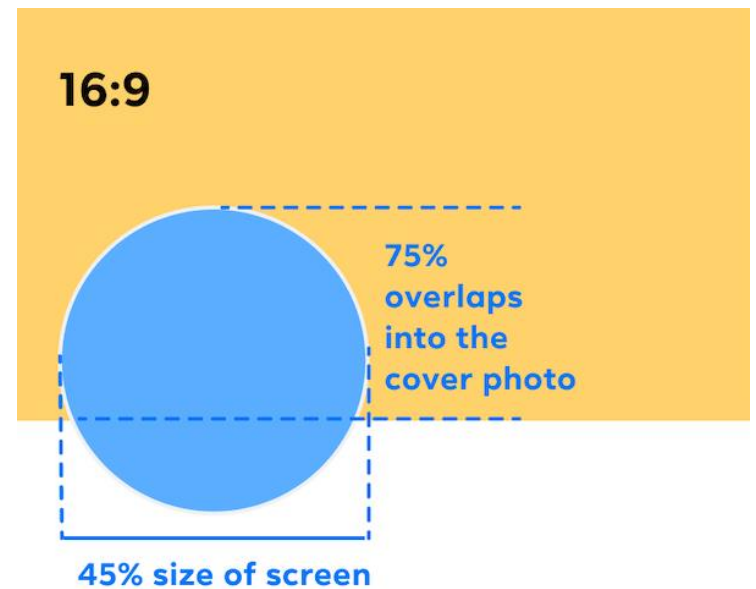
### Your Page's **cover photo**:

- Left aligns with a full bleed and a 16:9 aspect ratio.
- Must be at least 400 pixels wide and 150 pixels tall.
- Loads fastest as an sRGB JPG file that's 851 pixels wide, 315 pixels tall and less than 100 kilobytes.

For profile pictures and cover photos with your logo or text, you may get a better result by using a PNG file.

The left side of your cover photo will be partially covered by your profile picture, and may be cropped and resized to fit different screens.
