Most of us here on Kent Island have a love/hate relationship with the Bay Bridge. We love it when it works and curse it when it doesn't. It is our vital link to the Western Shore where many of you work. When the first bridge was built (1952) it was thought that it would never be outdated. The second bridge was added in 1973 and has reached capacity. The MD Transportation Authority has undertaken a study to examine a possible future crossing of the Bay. This TEIR 1 NEPA study started in 2017 and concludes in 2020. The purpose of this study is to identify the "Preferred Corridor Alternative". There will be numerous public meetings around the state this spring on this topic. Please stay informed and attend a meeting if possible. Our future is at stake.
