Avon Lake is a city in northeastern Lorain County, Ohio, United States, located on the southern shore of Lake Erie about 17 miles west of Cleveland. The population was 25,206 at the 2020 Census. It is part of the Cleveland metropolitan area.

NEED TO KNOW...

- Avon Lake is within the Centerline of Totality
- A once in a lifetime event
 - * Last one in Ohio in 1806
 - * Next one in Ohio will be in 2444
- Lorain County is 1 of only 9 Ohio counties that intersects with the centerline of totality
- Lorain County is estimating the population to increase to over 1 million people during the eclipse
- Ohio is within a one day drive of 70% of the U.S. population
