- 4. Recruitment, development, and mobilization of employees and volunteers as effective teams.
- 5. Coordination of board and administrative team activities for creation and maintenance of maximum organizational productivity.
- 6. Effective and prudent planning and oversight of all financial aspects of a nonprofit organization.
- 7. Development and management of a comprehensive, responsible risk management policy.
