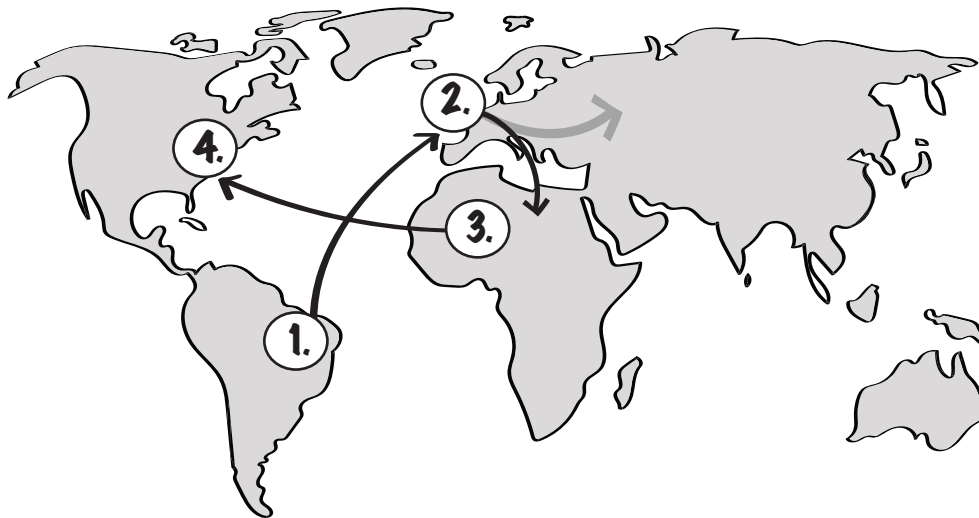

Peanuts originally grew in the South American country of Brazil but how it got to the United States will surprise you!



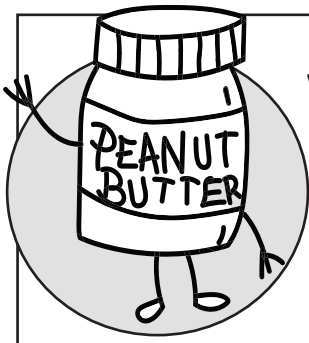

Improved farming methods helped increase peanut production.</p> <p>Dr. John Harvey Kellogg invented a version of Peanut Butter.</p>	<p>George Washington Carver found new ways to use peanuts and helped farmers grow better crops using peanuts.</p> <p>Peanuts became a major money-making crop in the South.</p>	<p>Peanuts are the 12th most valuable cash crop grown in the United States.</p> <p>Peanuts and peanut products contribute billions of dollars to the economy each year.</p>

South American Inca Indians were the first to grind peanuts to make peanut butter. The person who introduced peanut butter to the United States was Dr. John Harvey Kellogg, with his version in 1895. Dr. Kellogg is known as the father of cereal; his company makes Fruit Loops!
