



How do I host a wearing session?

If you have a couple of friends who'd like to get together and weave, you can either host them at your home or contact us for suggestions of venues that have offered to provide space. Nest then sends each of you our easy-to-use weaving loom (or one to share) and you weave the mats at your own pace, over one or several sessions, taking guidance from our step-by-step online videos. Suitable for any number of attendees.



Do I need to know how to weave?

Not at all! We show you each simple step in our online videos. We teach our method in primary schools, so it's easy for all ages to learn quickly. But beware - it's quite addictive!



Do I need any equipment?

All you need are scissors and one of our custom weaving looms, which you can order from us. Valued at \$120, we offer the looms to our weavers at the cost price of just \$60, with free postage. The looms are easy-to-use, compact for easy storage and best of all, they can be used for lots of other fun activities (see our website for ideas).



Can children do the weaving?

Yes! It's a great family charity activity for all ages. Under 8s can sort/cut the bags, while over 8s/adults can weave the mats. It's a great way to teach kids about compassion and community service.



Where do I get the plastic bags?

It takes roughly 500 bags to make a mat. It's best environmentally if you collect plastic bags from friends/family, but if you don't have enough, we got you! Nest can provide you with bags from our recycling stock.



How much of my time will this take?

It takes around 3 sessions for one person to make a mat, so you can spread that over a couple of get-togethers if you like, OR if you all work on different sections at the same time, you can complete a whole mat in one session The more time you can spend, the more people we can help!
