



What is "Nest and Sip"?

Nest & Sip is a 4-hour afternoon workshop (usually 2-6pm) taught live by Julie, where you come together and weave a sleeping mat, while enjoying drinks, snacks and music at a gorgeous bar. At the end of the session, your completed mats are collected by Nest, and we distribute them for you via our homeless service partners.



Do I need to know how to weave?

Not at all! Julie will teach you our simple method in this simple, step-by-step class. It's easy to learn and lots of fun!



Do I need any equipment?

None at all. Julie will bring weaving looms for use during the class, which will also be available for purchase after class if you desire (at the discounted rate of S40 for Nest and Sip students).



Do I need to bring plastic bags?

Plastic bags will be provided, but the more the merrier (and the better for the planet!), so bring along any that you have!



Can I bring kids?

This event is strictly over 18's as it will be held in a bar. HOWEVER we will soon also be holding cafe-based Nest and Sips, so please register your interest if you have under-18s keen on attending.



Are food/drinks available?

Food and drinks are available for purchase. These would be at your own cost. Your fee covers the tuition, venue and equipment only. Please note that there is no BYO allowed.
